The undersigned maker/owner understands the above conditions and agrees to release OGQG from any liability from any claim for damage or loss resulting from loan of any quilt show item.

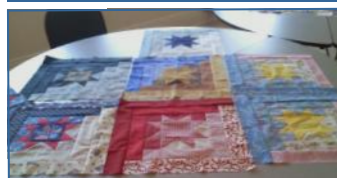
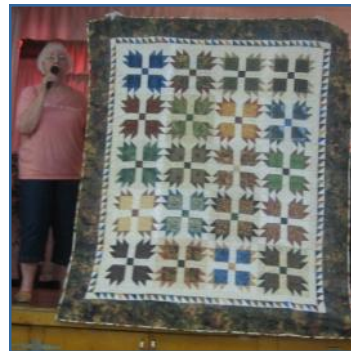

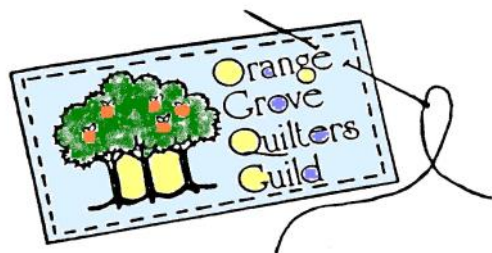
