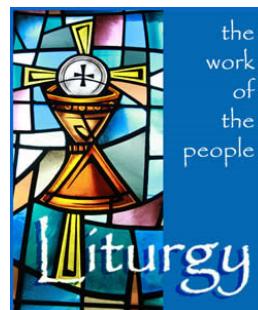

This past week, our Liturgy Committee reviewed and responded to questions regarding Masses and time for private prayer. The signup genius has been working very well and allows us to provide a chart for the greeters to maximize our seating capacity. Please remember that masks should be worn while entering and leaving the church for your protection and those you come in contact with. Since Zach has returned to school, we will add a Eucharistic Minister (EMHC) and also have a server (servers if from the same family). Our EMHC and I will both wear a mask while distributing communion. I ask that you keep your hand flat so that the host can be placed in your palm without contact. Also, the church will be open during the week from 6:30am until 4:30pm for private prayer.

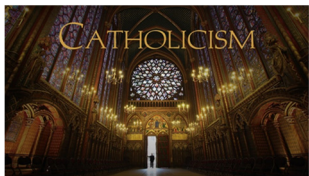
The meeting will be held outside at the Effingham Event Center (KC Hall) Pavilion. All parents are welcome!

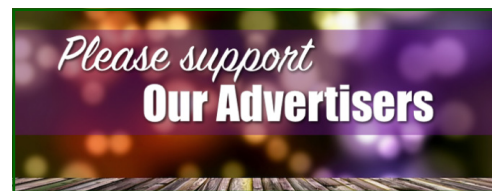
