- ▶ **TEAM CONNECT- IMPORT PLAYER BUTTON NOT WORKING**
- ▶ When you see the Blue *IMPORT* below your drop down button, but it does not seem to be working, move your cursor around it, until you see the *HAND*, then click.
- ▶ Sometimes the screen Font is smaller or larger and the word *IMPORT* is hidden in other text. Try using Ctrl+ or Ctrl- (Command+ or Command- on Mac) to increase or decrease screen size and make *IMPORT* visible, so you are able to click.

- ▶ *This helps your own players know what color to wear (Home and Away) and the opponent, to know if there is a conflict.*
- ▶ *Please note: ALL players are to have a number on the back of their jersey, this is a rule. When wearing an alternate uniform, there is usually some leniency. The easy way to avoid problems is NOT to give the referee a reason to need your number, except for scoring and assisting goals 😊.*

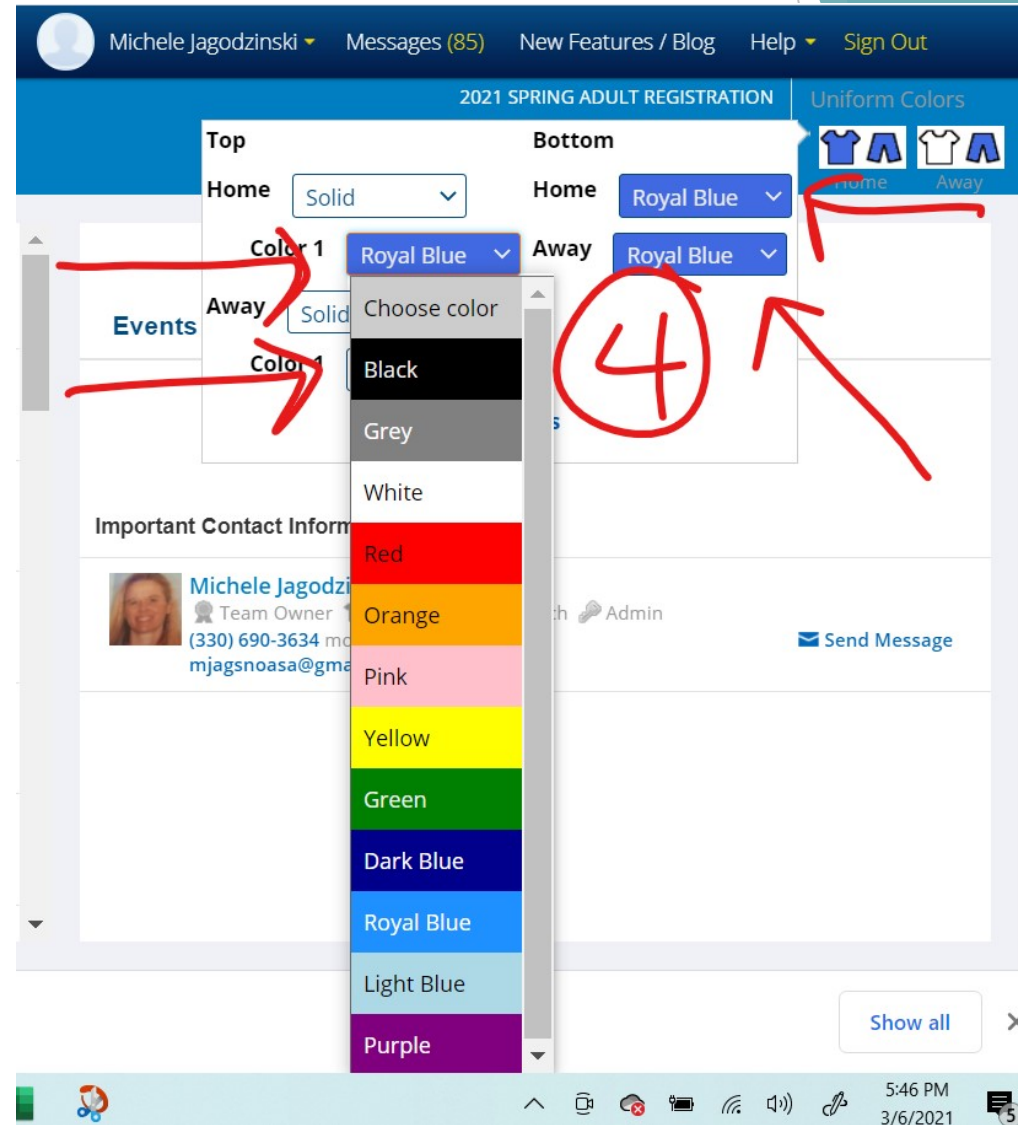

- ▶ **TEAM CONNECT-** Choosing Uniform Colors
- ▶ You have to pick both **Home** and **Away** colors for the top and bottom of the uniform.
- ▶ You can choose *Black* for bottoms to be generic.
- ▶ Please choose the *AWAY* color so your team mates know what color to carry, as an alternate. This makes pre-game easier when 2 teams have similar colors or the colors are difficult to distinguish, especially with setting sun glare at certain fields. Don't make it difficult for the referee or your own players.

- ▶ **WAIVERS:- Code of Conduct**

NOASA Code of Conduct

NOASA Code of Conduct

We welcome you to the Northern Ohio Adult Soccer Association ("NOASA")!

The purpose of NOASA is to meet the competitive and recreational soccer needs of adults with an emphasis on camaraderie and sportsmanship. NOASA welcomes all eligible friendly players, but we emphasize that playing soccer within NOASA is a privilege. In order to continue this privilege NOASA requires that our players conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner and with utmost respect for NOASA, other players and other individuals within our league. NOASA requires all players to review and abide by this Code of Conduct and to sign the acknowledgement below.

In connection with any and all NOASA activities, I agree:

1. and acknowledge that NOASA has zero tolerance for discrimination or harassment on the basis of race, color, sexual orientation, religion, national or ethnic origin, political beliefs, veteran status or disability unrelated in the ability to participate in the sport of soccer and I agree not to engage in any discriminatory or harassing behavior in connection with all NOASA activities. I agree to respect the rights, dignity, and worth of every person regardless of race, color, sexual orientation, religion, national or ethnic origin, political beliefs, veteran status or disability;
2. violence and unsportsmanlike behavior are threatening to NOASA and will not be tolerated, including, without limitation, violent behavior, threatening behavior and/or remarks, repeated foul language, denigrating remarks, unsportsmanlike behavior, rude gestures, spitting at an individual, yelling at or disparaging teammates, opposing players, referees and/or spectators, engaging in unsafe play, taunting or excessive celebration, physical assault, or other inappropriate behavior or remarks. I agree not to engage in any such behaviors;
3. any actions or inactions portraying NOASA in a negative light and/or threatening and/or detrimental to NOASA directly or indirectly will not be tolerated and I agree not to participate in, facilitate or otherwise assist any such behaviors;
4. to follow all rules established by FIFA and NOASA;
5. to demonstrate respect to the referee(s) and I understand they will make mistakes;
6. that my attendance and on-time arrival to games are important to NOASA's and my team's success and I will use my best efforts to attend games and arrive on time; and
7. to strive to create a welcoming and fun atmosphere for everyone.

I hereby acknowledge and agree that I have read and understand the NOASA Code of Conduct and agree to abide by it and to practice good sportsmanship throughout my participation in NOASA.
