## Ask Dotti

Well, Spring has sprung and it's time to get outdoors and get some sunshine before it gets too hot. I have two recipes for you that I hope you will like. One is for the crock pot, so you can get out of the house and the other you can prepare ahead, refrigerate it and bake when it's time to get dinner going. Enjoy.
Tip; milk will last one week past the sell-by date in the fridge. One month in the freezer, but leave room in the carton for expansion.

## BROCCOLI AND CAULIFLOWER CASSEROLE

## 2 cups water

$1 / 2$ teaspoon salt
$11 / 2-2 \mathrm{lbs}$. broccoli and cauliflower pieces
milk
4-5 tablespoons butter
4 tablespoons flour
salt and pepper to taste
dash nutmeg
2 tablespoons fine dry bread crumbs
1-2 tablespoon grated parmesan cheese
1/8 teaspoon paprika


Bring water and salt to boil. Add broccoli and cauliflower; cook until just crisp tender. Drain, reserving liquid.
Add milk to veggie liquid to measure $21 / 2$ cups.
Place veggies in 2 qt . Baking dish.
Melt 3 tablespoons in saucepan, blend in flour, stirring until thick and bubbly. Gradually add milk mixture. Cook, stirring until thick and smooth. Season with salt and pepper and nutmeg.
Combine bread crumbs, parmesan cheese, and paprika, sprinkle over veggies.
Bake 450 degrees for 20 minutes.

Yield; 6 servings

## CHICKEN CACCIATORE IN CROCKPOT

Place cut-up chicken in crockpot.
Cover with 1 can of undrained cut-up tomatoes
1 cut-up onion
1 cut-up green pepper
minced garlic to taste
1 tablespoon Italian herbs
red pepper flakes to taste
Add mushrooms, if you have them on hand
Cook on low for 6-8 hours or until chicken is falling apart.
Serve over favorite pasta, sprinkle with plenty of Parmesan cheese.
