




Community Benefits Cards

- 3. Return to Ritchies or to your attendant who will pass it on to the committee to submit




Scan your card each time you shop and 0.5% of what you spent is allocated to NRPG, as long as we achieve the minimum \$2000 a month.

During the 17th - 21st September, come along dressed in your team colours. Don't have a favourite team? Come as any teams colours, have some fun!

















Toilet Training

- 1. Look for signs: showing interest, can follow simple instructions
- 2. Get ready: let them sit on the potty, sing a 'potty song'
- 3. Start: sit them on the potty 30min after a meal or when they ask. No more than 3-5min at a time. Encourage and remind your child.
- 4. Once you start it can take days, weeks or months. Stop if your child doesn't cooperate or you become stressed. Dry days happen before dry nights


