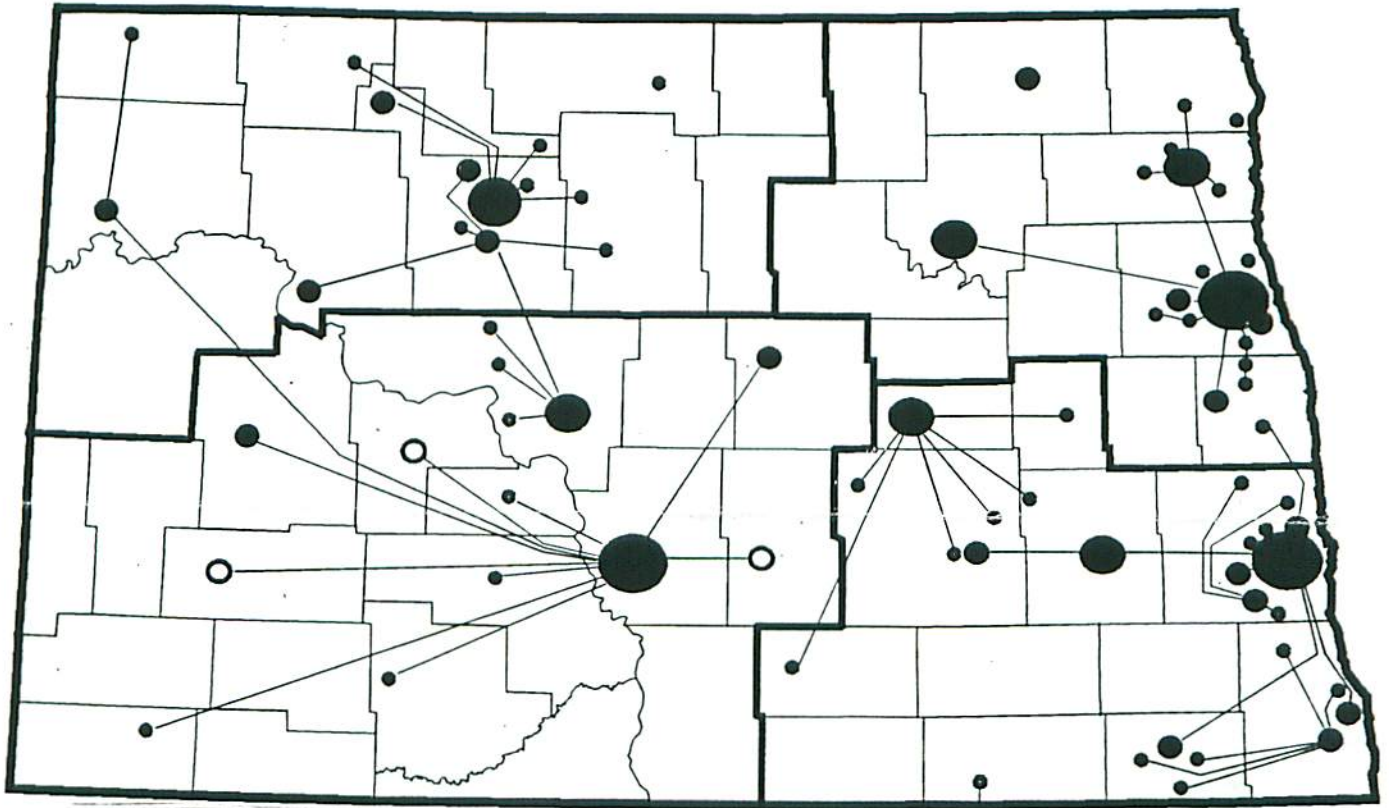


NORTH DAKOTA RECYCLING DIRECTORY



RECYCLING MAP: The map shows the current flow of processed recyclables in North Dakota. The drawing is based on information available October 1994. The largest circles represent the state's processing markets. They are identified in this directory as "1's" and "2's". All of the codes are described on page 2. Full service post-consumer recycling streams are illustrated. This includes the commodities aluminum cans, steel cans, newspaper, cardboard and glass.

NEW LISTING FEATURES: The 12th edition adds seven codes for newly recyclable commodities, seventy new recyclers, government information, and organizes entries by "clustering" recyclers who work together. Our directory identifies over three hundred twenty recyclers and services.

OTHER HOUSEHOLD MATERIALS

1. **CONSUMER GOODS** - (Second Hand Stores/Rummage Sales) Consider donating or purchasing clothes, furniture, appliances, art, rags, or any other item of value. Reuse North Dakota!
2. **YARD WASTE** - (Call City Public Works) Grass Clippings and Leaves can be composted in your back yard. Most cities have voluntary or mandatory yard waste programs. Reuse North Dakota!
3. **PLASTIC SHOPPING BAGS** - (Call Local Grocery or Department Store) Nearly all groceries and other stores collect plastic shopping bags in the entrance - (P4 or LDPE). Reuse North Dakota!
4. **EYE GLASSES** - (Call Community Lions Club) Most clubs have several drop sights in your city.
5. **HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE** - (Call Public Works Department) Most materials are toxic or harmful. Consider purchasing less toxic alternatives or smaller amounts. Reduce Toxicity North Dakota! Give usable products to family, neighbors, friends at work instead of throwing it all away.
6. **WHITE GOODS WITH "CFCs" (CHLOROFLUOROCARBONS)** - (Must be certified!) The Division of Environmental Engineering (Air Quality) enforces the Clean Air Act (701) 328-5188 and can describe the federal laws concerning the venting of ozone depleting chemicals. This concerns refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners and other "cooling" appliances. Federal fines may be \$25,000 w/\$10,000 given as a reward for prosecution.

OTHER AUTOMOTIVE MATERIALS

7. **AUTOMOTIVE COMPONENTS** - (Other Than Batteries) Radiators and catalytic converters contain valuable resources and some toxic metals. Please contact your community's scrap dealer and ask them.
8. **USED ANTIFREEZE** - (Can Often be Recycled) Contact your city or county. Some cities may allow disposal into sanitary sewers. Never put in septic systems/on the ground. Very Poisonous!
9. **USED ENGINE OIL** - (Public Do-It-Yourself) Contact your city or county officials or county extension agent. Most Amoco, Jiffy Lube, Cenex and many service stations collect. Very Toxic!
10. **AUTOMOTIVE REFRIGERANTS WITH "CFCs" (CHLOROFLUOROCARBONS)** - (Must be certified!) The Division of Environmental Engineering (Air Quality) enforces the Clean Air Act (701) 328-5188 and can describe the federal laws concerning the venting of ozone depleting chemicals. This concerns air conditioning units and refrigerant collection equipment. Federal fines may be \$25,000 w/\$10,000 given as a reward for prosecution.

OTHER MATERIALS

11. **USED GREASES/RENDERING** - (Department Listing or Phone Book) Look in yellow pages under rendering or restaurant greases and oils. The Department maintains a list and is available for free.
12. **USED PESTICIDE CONTAINERS** - (Triple Rinse + Recycle) Contact your pesticide dealer or the appropriate manufacturer. Some companies hold collections (Contact NDSU Extension Agent).
13. **USED/WASTE PESTICIDES** - (Use Rinsate per Label Directions) Contact State Department of Agriculture Operation Safe Send (701) 328-4756. This program is for agricultural chemicals/fertilizers.
14. **PCB BALLASTS RECOVERY** - (Call Health Department) Contact Conrad Carlson, State Hazardous Waste Program, (701) 328-5166. PCBs are regulated under the Toxic Substance Control Act.

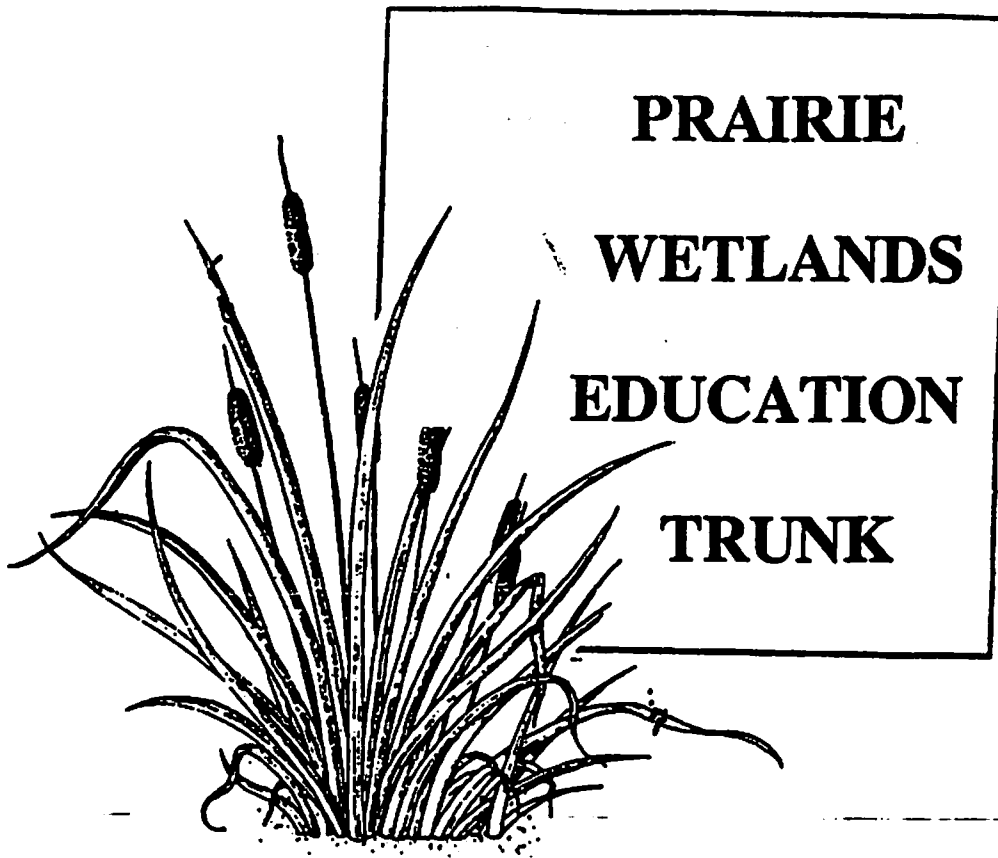

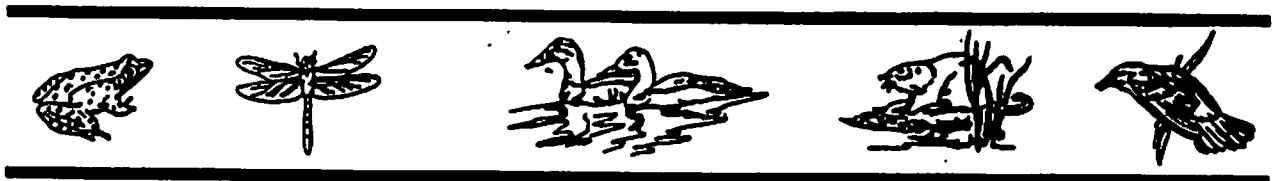
