NORTHEASTERN AT THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- The Huskies making their ninth appearance and second under Coach Mike Glavine (2018, at-large)
- Northeastern is 6-16 all-time in the NCAA tourney, 0-8 in NCAA Regionals
- · Last Appearance was in 2018 at the Raleigh Regional, falling to No. 2 seed Auburn (13-4) and No. 1 seed NC State (9-3)

QUICK HITS

- The Huskies won the CAA North Division Title and CAA tournament title for the first time
- Northeastern smashed 12 home runs and scored 37 runs over five games at the conference tourney
- The Huskies posted a school record 20-game winning streak from April 7-May 15, and tied a singleseason school record with 36 wins (Won 36 in 2018)
- NATIONAL RANKINGS: #3 in WHIP (1.11), Stolen Bases (2.56 per game), ERA (2.99), #4 in Winning Percentage (.778), #6 in H/9 (7.16), #9 Fielding Percentage (.981), K/BB ratio (3.29), BB/9 (2.81), #25 in Batting Average (.299) and #28 in On-Base Percentage (.394)

HUSKIES CAPTURE FIRST-EVER CAA TOURNAMENT CHAMPIONSHIP

- Ben Malgeri tied the game with a home run in the bottom of the ninth inning, and Max Viera hit a walk-off home run in the 10th inning to lead Northeastern to an 11-10 win over UNCW in the CAA title game
- After falling to UNCW 8-4 on Friday, the Huskies won three straight games, including two over UNCW to win the tournament championship
- *Malgeri* smashed five home runs in the tournament en route to being named Most Oustanding Player
- Malgeri, Jared Dupere Ian Fair, Max Viera and Cam Schlittler were all named to the CAA All-Tournament Team

Northeastern Heads to NCAA Fayetteville Regional

- After winning the CAA's automatic bid to the NCAA tournament, the Huskies earned a No. 3 seed and will take on No. 2 seed Nebraska on Friday at 8 p.m. ET
- This is the second NCAA Regional for the Huskies over the last three years, earning an at-large bid and No. 3 seed in 2018 at the NCAA Raleigh Regional, dropping both games to No. 2 seed Auburn and No. 1 seed NC State

DUPERE, SCHLITTLER AND GLAVINE COLLECT TOP CAA AWARDS

- Jared Dupere was named CAA Player of the Year, Cam Schlittler earned CAA Co-Rookie of the Year and head coach Mike Glavine was named CAA Coach of the Year, announced by the league office on Tuesday
- **Dupere** leads the CAA with a .807 slugging percentage and ranks third in the country with a school record 21 home runs
- **Schlittler** ranks seventh in the country with a 1.72 ERA and is a perfect 8-0 on the mound this season
- *Glavine* earns his third CAA Coach of the Year honor (2017, '18) after guiding the Huskies to a school record 20 consecutive wins, 20-3 CAA record, a league record 18-0 start to the CAA season and NU's first-ever tournament championship

HUSKIES GARNER ALL-CAA ACCOLADES

- Scott Holzwasser, Kyle Murphy and Max Viera join Dupere and Schlittler on the All-CAA first team
- Holzwasser started 40 games at second base and ranks second in the CAA with 22 stolen bases; He is the only player in college baseball to produce two SportsCenter No. 1 plays this season on March 3 and May 3
- *Murphy* is 6-1 as the No. 2 starter for the Huskies and ranks No. 19 in the NCAA with a 0.92 WHIP
- *Viera* reached base in 32-of-33 games this season and spent most of his time as a designated hitter
- Also earning all-conference recognition for the Huskies are *Jeff* Costello, Danny Crossen and Eric Yost on the All-CAA second team
- Costello is on fire heading into the CAA tournament, earning CAA Player of the Week (May 24) and is 10th in the CAA with a .342 batting average
- **Crossen** has been clutch for the Huskies all season long, hitting .388 with runners on and .818 with runners on third with less than two outs
- **Yost** is one of the most reliable arms out of the bullpen, and is fourth in the CAA with four saves

GOING, GOING, GONE!

- **Dupere** leads the CAA with a .807 slugging percentage, 57 runs scored and 21 home runs. He was named CAA Player of the Year becoming just the second Northeastern player to earn the distinction since 2006.
- His .351 batting average ranks sixth in the CAA and his 48 RBIs ranks second in the conference. He is on pace to become the all-time single-season leader at NU in slugging percentage.
- **Dupere's** moved ahead of former standout **Frank Pesanello** (2008) with his 21st home run on Sunday, May 30 in the CAA title game at UNCW

COACH GLAVINE APPROACHING 200 WINS

- *Mike Glavine* is coaching his seventh season for the Huskies, and is just five wins shy of 200
- His 195 wins is the most by any coach in school history over a sevenyear stretch and he was named CAA Coach of the Year for the third time this season (2017, '18, '21)

MAKING THE MOST OF THE BONUS YEAR

- Mainstays in the starting lineup since their arrival, Scott Holzwasser and Kyle Murphy have made this bonus year one of their best in a Northeastern uniform
- *Holzwasser* broke the career school record in stolen bases (80), runs scored (170) and HBP (53); He also broke a school record with a 44-game on-base streak (2019-21)
- Murphy ranks third all-time with 250 strikeouts and is ninth with 16 career wins

PUPS MAKING A BIG DIFFERENCE

- Several freshmen and sophomores are making a huge impact for the #HowlinHuskies
- Redshirt freshmen pitchers *Cam Schlittler* (8-0, 1.42 ERA) and *Sebastian Keane* (6-1, 3.93 ERA) have been dominant on the mound, throwing in the weekend rotation all season long
- Redshirt sophomores *Jared Dupere* (.351, 21 HR) and *Danny Crossen* (.345, 30 RBI) have been strong middle of the order forces for the Huskies
- Freshmen *Max Viera* (.341, 5 HR), *Wyatt Scotti* (4-1, 2.19 ERA), *Eric Yost* (1-2, 4 saves), *JP Olson* (.257, 18 RBI) found their way into the lineup early for the Huskies
- **Schlittler** was named CAA Co-Rookie of the Year, and earned a spot on the CAA All-Rookie Team with **Scotti** and **Viera**

SCORE EARLY. WIN

- The Huskies are 19-2 this season when scoring in the first inning and 28-2 when scoring first in the inning
- When their opponents score first, the Huskies are 8-8 this season and 7-5 when Northeastern allows a run or more in the first inning

THROW THE BALL, CATCH THE BALL, HIT THE BALL

- The famous line from the hit movie *Bull Durham* rings true for the #HowlinHuskies this season
- Northeastern leads the CAA in batting average (.298), earned run average (3.12) and fielding percentage (.980)
- The Huskies are 20-3 when posting a clean sheet in the error column and 29-8 when committing one error or less

THE GLAVINE FILE

Mike Glavine – the three-time CAA Coach of the Year (2017, '18, '21), 2018 NEIBA (New England) Coach of the Year and 2018 ABCA/Diamond Northeast Region Coach of the Year – is in his seventh season as head coach of the Northeastern baseball team and 15th season overall with the program.

It's been a historic season for the Huskies in 2021, capturing their first-ever CAA tournament title in dramatic fashion, 11-10, on a walk-off home run in the bottom of the 10th inning at UNCW. Northeastern won a single-season school record 36 games, and its 20-game winning streak (April 7-May 15) is a single-season school record. The Huskies lead the CAA in batting average, ERA, fielding percentage and stolen bases, ranking top 10 nationally in several of those categories. The 18-0 start to CAA play set a new conference record and the Huskies became the first No. 1 seed to win the CAA Championship since UNCW did so in 2012.

Glavine led the Huskies to a final RPI ranking of No. 11 in 2020, before the season was canceled due to the global pandemic Coronavirus. *Baseball America* did a vote by coaches around the country in April 2020 and Coach Glavine earned the fourth-most votes as the 'most underrated College Baseball Coach' (story here).

Since Glavine took over the baseball program, the Huskies have won a program-best 195 games over a seven-year stretch. The Huskies have never had a losing season inside the CAA under Glavine's guidance, and Cleveland Indians' hurler Aaron Civale earned All-America honors in 2016. A total of 40 players have garnered all-league honors and NU has never finished lower than fifth during Glavine's tenure.

A native of Billerica, Mass., Glavine spent four years as a player at Northeastern and left as one of the most prolific hitters in the Huskies' history. Glavine graduated having hit 28 career home runs and accumulated 110 career RBIs, ranking him third and ninth at the time, respectively, in school history. The left-handed slugger also walked 120 times during his four seasons at NU, ranking him second all-time upon completing his final collegiate campaign.

After graduating from Northeastern, Glavine spent 10 seasons in professional baseball after being drafted by the Cleveland Indians during 1995, alternating between AA and AAA levels. During September 2003, the New York Mets called Glavine up to the major leagues, where he played with his older brother and MLB Hall of Famer, Tom. Glavine became the third Northeastern alumni to ever play in the major leagues, joining George Yankowski (1942, 1949) and Carlos Peña (2001-14).


