Message from Kevin Quinn, Parish Administrator

Dear Friends

Just like all of you, I have been struggling with the rollercoaster-like turn of events of the national health pandemic created by the spread of COVID-19. The realities of managing the ups and downs, uncertainties, and momentary crises in both my personal family life and parish life over the past few months has been, at times, exhausting and anxiety producing! However, I truly believe as though the light at the end of this strange tunnel is growing larger. I have accepted the reality that things will be different and have recently began to see that some of those changes may actually be positive.

I pray along with you for the worry of those who are sick and the sorrow of those who have already lost a loved one to this virus. I recognize the gravity of the reality that in this moment of collective trauma and crisis, the negative effects are experienced much more drastically by those who are already vulnerable in our society— the elderly, those in poverty, those with disabilities, those in foster care or without safe and loving family structures. I also recognize that there are also very remarkable responses unfolding, as we push ourselves not to be paralyzed by a state of despair.

This health crisis continues to expose the extreme fissures in our society and the deep and abiding obligation that we, collectively, have to help society get things right as we move towards the future and the changes that undoubtedly lie ahead.

Like most other places, we (our collective community) are embracing the changes and are finding new ways to be in community, to be together. And, at the same time, our hearts and minds reel as we witness the collective fall-out from the effects of the pandemic on our community.

As your daily lives have become reconfigured to a degree, I ask how can you be more in control of the reconfiguration? It may be that **social distancing** isn't quite the right frame for what we all need right now. We certainly need **physical distancing**, but we also need to imagine and act from places of social closeness and care. What if we recognized this moment as also a possibility of significant change? Is it possible that we have a chance to reconfigure life towards the world that we want? What kinds of questions should we ask, what kinds of reimagining can we do together?

We are all thinking about these big questions. We, the parish of Notre Dame de la Mer, also think about how we can support our Faith-Filled Community in this moment, and about our role in meeting some of the very acute needs of our members, schools, and families that are pressing and urgent in our local world!.

I hope that you and your loved ones are well, and I hope that you believe that we (The Parish Team) have, over the past few months, shown the ability to think outside the box and commit to you more than ever to do our work in a way that supports all in our community of faith. I ask that you be open to the changes that will come along as we move ahead.

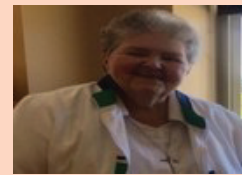

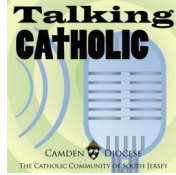

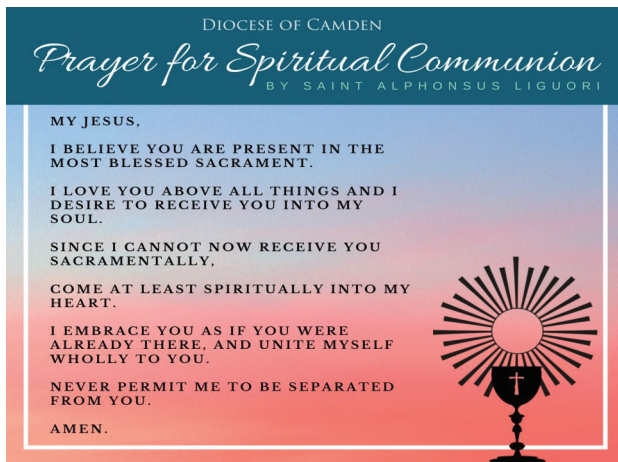


Family Reflection Corner

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

Choose one of the following activities as a way to further reflect on the Sunday readings.

- This Sunday, Jesus tells us: “Deny yourself, take up your cross, and begin to follow in my footsteps.” Make footprints on paper using the outlines of each family member’s foot. Cut the footprints out, and ask each person to print on his or her foot one way he or she will follow the way of Jesus this week.
- To follow Jesus, to do the will of God, comes at a cost. Invite family members to answer the question: When is it difficult for you to follow Jesus? Remind family members that with God’s grace and help, anything is possible.
- Have each family member cut a cross from construction paper. On the crosses, describe a cross that you will carry for Jesus this week. Keep the crosses on the refrigerator or in another prominent place in your home as a reminder of your commitment to Christ.



Liturgy Corner...learn something new or maybe even become inspired !

What is the Liturgy of the Hours?

Have you ever noticed in old films a priest with a small black book? Most people assume this is the Bible, but it most likely is the Breviary. The Breviary is a prayer book that contains three psalms, a reading from Scripture, a response, and a prayer. The two major hours, Morning Prayer (*Lauds*) and Evening Prayer (*Vespers*), include a Gospel canticle and intercessions. The Liturgy of the Hours, as the Church describes them, is the extension of the Mass. It is another way to continue the Mystery of the Liturgy throughout the day.

Although described as “hours,” each “hour” only takes about 15-20 minutes. The reason for using the word hour is to signify the different hours of the day in which the proper set of psalms and prayers are to be said. For example, you shouldn’t be praying Vespers at 9 o’clock in the morning. You should try to match up the hours with the proper time of day.

Prior to Vatican II, this was known as “The Divine Office” or simply “The Office.” This form of prayer was excluded only for religious and priests. Ordained clergy then and even now are **required** to pray these “hours” by The Code of Canon Law (Church Law). Vatican II, however, recognized that the laity, meaning those who are not ordained, should also be encouraged to pray this beautiful treasure of the Church. This is why Holy Mother Church invites and encourages the faithful to pray the Liturgy of the Hours.
