Many of our usual activities (hosting visiting Salvadoran scholarship students, Fiesta and Salvadoran Craft Fair) have been placed on pause due to the pandemic. We plan to resume these efforts as soon as we are able. This coming February, members of the St. Elizabeth delegation will travel to El Salvador. Since 2013, we have had 58 different travelers, 8 of whom have gone multiple times.

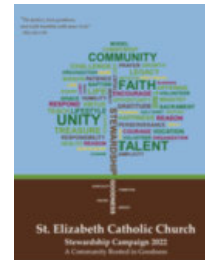
### Parish Feasibility Study: Please Share Your Input

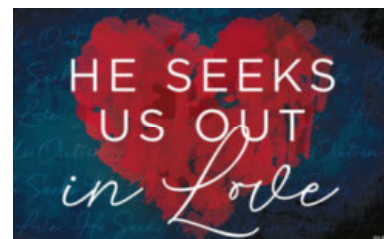
## 2022 Stewardship Campaigns
