



NOTICE from the Spokane Diocese:

This past July you were sent a notice regarding David Haas, a well-known composer of liturgical songs. We are now following up on that notice. Mr. Haas is being actively investigated by the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and the Archdiocese of Minneapolis due to allegations of sexual misconduct against multiple women. These women have indicated that the use of Mr. Haas's music in the liturgy is the source of great pain so we have requested that you discontinue the use of his liturgical songs.
