Shodankeh Johnson THURSDAY NIGHT

Shodankeh B.E.B. Johnson was born in 1965 in Freetown, Sierra Leone. His father was a Christian and his mother a Muslim. Early on, he felt drawn to become a pastor. After completing his academic training, he attended a church gathering where the speaker invited Christians to go for six months to the millions of Muslims living in Northern Sierra Leone. That call resonated with him, and he went forward. Influenced by his mother, he nurtured a lifelong love for Muslims that would eventually change the spiritual trajectory of his country.


In 2001, Shodankeh attended a
Perspectives on the World Christian
Movement in Murfreesboro, and heard
David Watson, a highly successful pioneer
of Disciple Making Movements. In 2005
Shodankeh's ministry hosted the first DMM
training in Africa. Grounded in abundant
prayer and a focus on Unreached and
Unengaged people, Shodankeh has trained
and coached thousands of Christian leaders
around the world to launch sustainable and
replicable Disciple Making Movements.



Pino Neglia FRIDAY NIGHT

Pino Neglia was brought to Christ through the mission service of Charles and Jessie Lee Troyer in 1969, in Pino's home country of Italy. Pino was educated at the Florence Bible College in Italy, Florence University of Political Science, and Cincinnati Christian Seminary. Upon the death of Charles Troyer in 1988, Pino became the director of Lecce Christian Mission and the editor of the magazine, Restoration Workshop (Officina di Restaurazione).

In 1991, Pino began working in Albania evangelizing and planting churches through his mission. By 1997, he had become the director of the Conference of Italian Churches of Christ to Torre dell'Orso, which serves both the instrumental and non-instrumental Churches of Christ. In partnership with Let's Start Talking, he started a program in 2014 to teach English using the Bible in both Lecce and Albania.



Dr. Orpheus Heyward SATURDAY NIGHT

Dr. Orpheus Heyward has been at Renaissance Church of Christ (formerly West End Church of Christ) in Atlanta since 2003, first as assistant minister, and then as senior minister since 2006. Having received his Master of Arts in Theology, Master of Arts in Biblical Studies and later completing his Doctor of Ministry in Theological Exegesis, his biblical expertise and understanding of the Word is supreme.

Due to his acknowledged expertise in presenting the Word of God, Dr. Heyward is frequently requested to speak on national and regional lectureships, and conducts revivals all across the country. He is considered one of the most dynamic and scripturally sound gospel preachers among Churches of Christ today. He is able to articulate with profound simplicity the Word of God, and provide practical applications for everyday challenges.



Dr. Rick Cherok SUNDAY MORNING

Dr. Rick Cherok was born in Barberton, Ohio and raised in the Barberton First Church of Christ. He completed degrees at Kentucky Christian University and the University of Akron before graduating with his PhD in United States Religious History from Kent State University.

Dr. Cherok has taught Christian History and Restoration History at Cincinnati Christian University and Ozark Christian College for more than two decades. In addition to contributing numerous essays and articles to a variety of publications, Dr. Cherok has also published *Debating for God: Alexander Campbell's Challenge to Skepticism in Antebellum America.*

Dr. Cherok has served in youth, preaching, and interim ministries with several churches and currently serves on the editorial board of the Stone-Campbell Journal and as the editor for the College Press Publishing Company. He has led hundreds of people on short-term mission trips to various locations around the world and is the founder and executive director of Celtic Christian Mission.






