Large Animal Rescue Team

Dear Equestrian,

The *City of San Juan Capistrano's* Large Animal Response Team (LART) is looking for additional volunteers to become members of the team. Recently the *San Juan Capistrano* LART program has been expanded to respond and assist with the evacuation and sheltering of horses and other large animals during disasters throughout Orange County. Experienced equestrians are encouraged to apply and take the certification training that will enable them to respond to large animal disasters.

Upon successful completion of training, volunteers will be sworn in as Certified Disaster Workers. **LART** volunteers will also attend disaster drills, have the opportunity to attend advanced specialized training, and be activated to respond and assist during county-wide emergencies.

We would like to invite any experienced equestrians to a **LART LEVEL 1** through **3 TRAINING CLASS**. This is a two part class, and both sections, lecture and lab will need to completed to be certified. A **Level 3 LART** can work in a disaster reception area and be activated to join a trailer team.

The **mandatory** class portion will be held:

The mandatory LART lab and testing will be held:

Sunday, November 10, 2013
