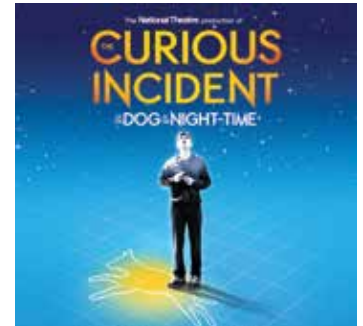

GUEST PASSES

Below are some helpful pointers about guest passes, including when your guest **needs** a pass and when your guest **benefits** from having a pass.

When is it required for a guest to have a guest pass?

If they are visiting the facilities without a member, they must present an active guest pass upon arrival in each department (hard copy or via their phone).

Do my guests need a pass if I am with them?

No. However, family guest passes offer discounts with an active guest pass. Furthermore, houseguests visiting for longer periods of time may obtain a pass to use golf and tennis facilities, and card rooms, more than the day guest allowance.

When is it beneficial for a guest to have a guest pass?

- Tee time reservations for defined family guests
- Fitness access from 3 to 7 consecutive days for defined family guests
- When a guest would like to play golf or cards with the member more than the permitted day guest allowance

Important to Know

- No pass + no member = no service
- No family pass = no family discount
- No member = no golf access

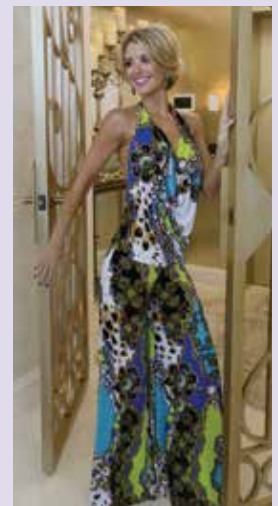

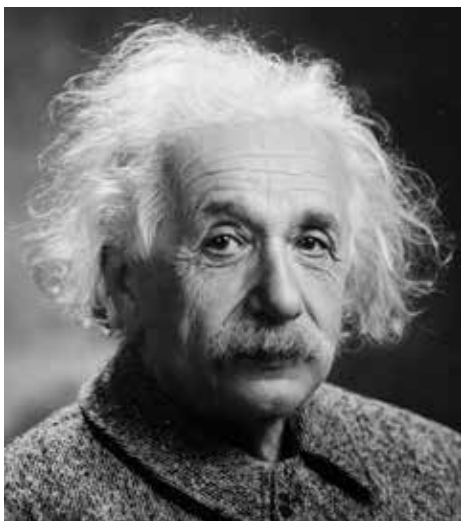
