VESSEL WALKTHROUGH

This custom 75' WestBay SonShip cockpit motoryacht exudes an air of quality and refinement. The three stateroom accommodation arrangement with particularly sumptuous owner's and VIP guest cabin, are tastefully furnished with clean and uncluttered design, finished to superb standard by the best craftsman. The yacht is equipped throughout with the top-end navigation, entertainment and mechanical systems. The interior layout starting forward with the VIP stateroom with a queen bed, head and stall shower, hanging locker, a centerline companionway with a guest stateroom, a stairwell up to the pilothouse and laundry center to starboard, further aft is the full beam Master stateroom with ensuite head and full shower. The pilothouse features a centerline helm/Nav station, twin Stidd helm chairs and a large "U" shaped dinette. The Galley follows aft. Down a step to the Main Salon with a wet bar and entertainment center to starboard, opposite to port is a large sofa and table. The California deck has a double stainless steel and glass entry doors and there are steps port and starboard leading down to the cockpit. The crew quarters are below the California deck. The engine and machinery spaces are located below the salon and are accessed by a watertight door from the cockpit.

COCKPIT/LAZARETT

Entering from the Transom step through the transom door is the custom factory built cockpit. Set up for serious fishing, diving or just easy access to the dock or tender while at anchor. There is a large watertight door to the crew quarters and walk in engine room at the inside side of the cockpit. This area includes:

CALIFORNIA DECK

Coming up from the cockpit on either side up 4 teak steps and through custom stainless locking gates to this great entertaining area. The California deck is open and roomy with a custom settee and large table at the aft end. This area combined with 4 chairs around the table could easily seat 8 people for dining or just enjoying a sunny afternoon. The double built in grill next to the entrance to the main salon also adds to this areas usability.

On the outer side of entrance to the main salon are two built in cabinets (each side) that house the stern “hide away” engine controls with bow and stern thruster controls as well. This is one of the many spectacular innovations developed by West Bay.

MAIN SALON

Entering from the California Deck through two stainless and glass double doors to the roomy and open Main salon. The left side is taken up by a huge u-shaped couch with two large windows behind. The opposite side is cherry wood cabinetry housing the stereo system and pop up TV and storage lockers. This area includes:

GALLEY

The spacious and well arranged galley is complimented by Corian countertops, all necessary amenities for the chef and large windows providing a panoramic view. This area overlooks and is on the same level as the pilothouse and is great for the person cooking as they are in the mix with people running the boat. This area includes:

PILOTHOUSE

The raised pilothouse features a fully instrumentized navigation station with excellent visibility for navigation with a 180 degree panoramic view. Twin Stidd helm chairs. Aft of the helm chairs is a large "U" shaped observation couch with a table. There are port and starboard side doors for access to the side decks.

Another feature of this area is the ability to turn the helm chairs around facing the large table (with the filler) and dine with others at the table, accommodating six people easily.

MASTER STATEROOM

Going down from the pilothouse a curved stairway you enter the sleeping cabin level for owner and guests. Going all the way aft is the full beam owner's suite. There is a center walk around King Bed. With built in cabinets on either side with granite countertops. There are two large walk in hanging lockers (cedar lined) on each side. There is a liberal use of cherry wood through out this cabin with many drawers and a full vanity forward to port.
