### Cap

The NSCC Mini Left Side Flash will be worn by Officers, Midshipmen, Instructors and NSCC Cadets. The NLCC Mini Flash will be worn by NLCC Cadets. Please note that rank insignia is NOT worn on the NWU eight point cover.





## NWU SHIRT VIEW AND PATCH PLACEMENT



### • SHIRT.

The NSCC mini flashes will NO LONGER BE REQUIRED to be worn by Officers, Midshipmen, Instructors and NSCC Cadets on each shoulder pocket with eagles facing forward and bottom-edge parallel to the deck. A full-sized left facing NSCC flash will be worn on the left breast pocket to be sewn over the existing USN

### NWU NAME TAPES



Name Tapes. Will be worn on all shirts with the name over the right breast pocket and USNSCC over left breast pocket.

Breast Insignia. Strips will be placed directly over the "USNSCC" strip on the left breast pocket and shall match color and fabric as uniform component and shall be the length of the width of the pocket. Authorized breast devices are NSCC Silver and Gold Wings, EOD, SEAL, SWCC or authorized USN warfare device. Unit or Regional Director's Command Badge(s) are worn in the primary position, over name strip, or secondary position, on left breast pocket flap, as appropriate. Breast Devices will be embroidered in silver and/or gold on blue digital/pattern as required. No more than two devices may be worn.




### RATE INSIGNIA PLACEMENT

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### NWU BELTS & BOOTS



- Belt. Officers, Midshipmen, Instructors, and Chief Petty Officers, will wear a khaki web belt with gold tip and buckle. NSCC Cadets PO1 and below will wear a black belt with silver tip and buckle.
- Footwear. NWU will be worn with a smooth leather black boot with 8 inch or 9 inch upper. Trouser legs will be bloused to boot tops with blousing bands (not tucked), to present a neat appearance.









### NSCC/NLCC BDUs



- Shirt/Pants: Woodland Camouflage
- Cover: Woodland Camouflage (NSCC/NLCC flash sewn in place of Navy rate)
- Undershirt: Desert brown, crew neck t-shirt (sleeves must not extend past the uniform shirt, visible portion of the neck must not have rips/holes)
- Undergarments: Female: brassiere. Male and female under shorts: any color
- Belt: Black with black clip
- Socks: Black or olive drab (must cover calf of leg, no short socks)
- Shoes: Combat boots, black, polished and shined
  - Nametag: Olive drab nametape, centered ¼ inch above the right shirt pocket (ID card in left breast pocket)
    - NSCC/NLCC Nametape Olive drab NSCC/NLCC nametape, centered 1/4 inch about the left shirt pocket
- Ribbons: Not worn
- Shoulder Flash: Olive drab NSCC shoulder flashes are centered on the outer face of both sleeves with the top edge of the flash 1" below shoulder seam. NLCC shoulder flash sewn 1" below shoulder seam of right sleeve only.
- Unit Identification: Not worn
- Rank: Olive drab with black embroidery, sewn on the collar tabs as with the USNSCC NWUs
- New Cadets/Leaguers do not have rate insignia.








### FEMALE DRESS WHITES



### Female Dress Whites

The dress white jumper and trousers are pressed (ironed) in-side-out and seam to seam. The trouser creases follow the outter and inner surface of the leg. NSCC shoulder patches are worn on both shoulders. Rank cheverons are worn on the right shoulder—all patches are centered on the crease of the sleeve.

#### HAT

Wear squarely on head Do not wear on the back of head Do not have any hair showing under front of cover

#### Neckerchief

is worn with undress blues Press and roll only Do not press flat after rolling Upper edge of knot should be even with the point of V on the Jumper Keep ends even

### Sleeves

Should be long enough to reach the wrist joint Do not foll up, fold or slide up

#### Belt

Wear regulation white web only with regulation buckle

### Trousers

Keep them pressed
Check proper length
They should hang naturally, with no
break, and bottom front bearly
touching bottom part of shoe lacing

### Socks

Wear regulation black only

#### Undershirt

Wear regulation style only Clean Close-nitting Not frayed Not loose or oversized

#### Ribbons

Wear regulation only Wear in proper order Bottom row 1/4" above pocket and centered No space between rows

### Brease Insignia Wear centered and

lear centered and immediately above ribbons

### Rating cheverons

Worn on right sleeve 3 1/2" below NSCC patch

### NSCC Shoulder Patch

1" below shoulder seam Unit name tab is 1/2" below NSCC patch

#### Jumper

Should hang straight (not form fitting and should cover all but lowest side button of trousers Wron with zipper front, jumper should fall 1/2" below lower end of slash pocket

### Shoes

Must be highly shined Wear regulation leather only Corfram is NOT suthorized for enlisted Cadets



## SEA CADET'S DRESS WHITES UNIFORM



- Dress Whites
- White polyester jumper with cadet patches and rating badges
- White round neck T-shirt
- Black neckerchief
- Name tag (plastic), over right jumper pocket
- Ribbon bar, over left jumper pocket
- Long, white polyester trousers
- White belt with silver buckle
- Black socks
- Black dress shoes
- Males are to wear white Dixie cover, females are to wear black combo cover
- Pressing Your Dress Whites
- Jumper
- Front should have one crease pressed down the middle facing outward
- Back should have one crease pressed facing inward
- Collar should be folded in three with seams pressed outward
- Trousers
- Press inside out seam-to-seam, no creases



### NSCC FLASH PLACEMENT



- NSCC
- Flash Pair. The NSCC cadet shoulder flash consists of an embroidered yellow border, with yellow lettering and eagle, on a blue field for both blue and white uniforms. They can also be worn on the Utility and Coverall uniforms, however, the gunfighter flash is NOT worn on the left sleeve of the utility, only the white and blue jumpers. For the camouflage utility uniform, the embroidered cadet black on olive drab shoulder flash will be worn. There is only one size for both males and females.
- Position. Will be worn on the outer face of each sleeve of all uniforms, jumpers, blouses, shirts, coats and all other outer garments except raincoats, and it can also be worn on the front of the blue working cap. The flash will be centered on the front immediately above the bill, with the eagle pointing toward the right shoulder. The flash will be centered on the outer face of each sleeve with, the top edge of the flash 1-inch below the shoulder seam, with the eagles facing forward.




### DUNGAREES/UTILITY UNIFORM



- Dungarees
- Blue chambray short sleeve shirt with cadet badges and rating patches (sleeves must be cut to same length as tropical white shirt sleeve)
- Name tag (embroidered style), over right pocket
- White round neck T-shirt
- Blue working ball cap
- Blue trousers with butt patch name tag over the back-right pocket (embroidered style)
- Black belt with silver buckle
- Black socks
- Black dress shoes or boots
- Press Your Dungarees
- Trousers
- Press like regular dress trousers, creases down front and back



### DRESS BLUES



### **Dress blues**

The dress blue jumper and trousers are pressed (ironed) in-side-out and seam to seam. The trouser creases follow the outter and inner surface of the leg. NSCC shoulder patches are worn on both shoulders. Rank cheverons are worn on the right shoulder--all patches are centered on the crease of the sleeve

DO NOT MACHINE WASH - DRY CLEAN ONLY.

#### HAT

Wear squarely on head Bottom edge horizontal Do not roll, bend or crush brim Keep spotless Replace when heavily soiled Wear your correct size Wear White Hat with diagonal seam of brim to the rear

#### Neckerchief

is worn with undress blues Press and roll only Do not press flat after rolling Upper edge of knot should be even with the point of V on the Jumper Keep ends even

#### Jumper

Should hang straight (not form fitting and should cover all but lowest side button of trousers

#### Trousers

Keep them pressed
Check proper length
They should hang naturally, with no
break, and bottom front bearly
touching bottom part of shoe lacing

#### Socks

Wear regulation black only

#### Undershirt

Wear regulation style only Clean Close-nitting Not frayed Not loose or oversized

#### Ribbons

Wear regulation only
Wear in proper order
Bottom row 1/4" above
pocket and centered
No space between rows

### Cuffs

Don't fold them back Keep buttoned at all times

#### Striping (Piping) Keep it clean



#### NLCC PATCHWORK PLACEMENT



- NTCC
- Flash Single. The NLCC cadet shoulder flash consists of an embroidered white border, with white lettering and a yellow fouled anchor, on a blue field. There is only one size for both males and females.
- Position. Will be worn on the left sleeve of all uniform, blouses, shirts, coats and all other outer garments except raincoats, and it can also be worn on the front of the blue working cap, the flash will be centered on the front immediately above the bill. The flash will be centered on the outer face of the left sleeve, with the top edge of the flash 1-inch below the shoulder seam.






