

"Say No to ROE"

The state legislature has extended the session until January 5th, 2021. Please remind the members of the Joint Committee on Judiciary that you oppose the expansion of abortion in Massachusetts. Please call the Committee at 617-722-2396 and let them know you are **opposed** to H3320 and S1209 – the ROE legislation. Every telephone call helps!

Remember these bills would remove:

*The requirement that young girls obtain consent before an abortion

*The requirement that efforts be made to save a living baby who survives abortion

*The requirement that late term abortions be performed in hospitals

* And the bills would allow abortion on demand for all nine months of pregnancy.

Dear Parents & Guardians,

The past seven months have been quite difficult and trying for all of us. The COVID-19 Pandemic has affected us all in some way and we are stronger because of it. Surely, it will be a memory that will last several generations; just like the faith that we pass on to our children.

In years past, we have had in-person religious education programs that have been diligently taught by our dedicated catechists (teachers). However, because of the pandemic we are going to be moving in a direction where we are going to empower you, the parents, to be the teachers of your children. According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church (CCC) # 2223:

"Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children. They bear witness to this responsibility first by creating a home where tenderness, forgiveness, respect, fidelity, and disinterested service are the rule. The home is well suited for education in the virtues. This requires an apprenticeship in self-denial, sound judgment, and self-mastery-the preconditions of all true freedom. Parents should teach their children to subordinate the 'material and instinctual dimensions to interior and spiritual ones.' Parents have a grave responsibility to give good example to their children. By knowing how to acknowledge their own failings to their children, parents will be better able to guide and correct them."

For students in Grades 1-8:

The curriculum that we will be giving you is called "Project Nazareth" which has been developed by the Archdiocese of Boston and is free of charge for all families within the Archdiocese. This <u>video</u> from the Archdiocese explains the program. This will be for students for grades 1-5, but we feel as though it will benefit students in grades 1-8.

For students in Confirmation:


The curriculum that we will be using is called Chosen, which is put out by Ascension Press. A video describing it can be found <u>here</u>. We will also be using a completely remote option for this coming year. The students who are in 9th & 10th Grade should register for this option.
