What are your favorite parts of working on BackStage Pass?

So many parts... I love working with our staff and students! We get to discover and explore new music during the casting process, then bring these musicians into our studios for a performance, open to a free taping for our community.

How has BackStage Pass expanded over the last 10 seasons?

We still and always will highlight our Michigan musicians, but we've expanded by drawing acts from across the country to our studios. I hope that *BackStage Pass* continues to put Michigan music on the map and cultivate artists within our community while drawing musicians from other parts of the country to our area because of our rich and vibrant music scene.
