Why is support for this WKAR original series important?

Music is our unspoken way to connect with others on a deeper emotional level, and whether you come to our taping and experience that in our studios, or you are at home in front of the TV, computer, or iPhone, I would hope that our show and our musicians move you to feel, reflect, or pause for a moment to slow down and appreciate the deep connection we can all tap into through music.
