1 Write your name, handphone number and location within church on the form provided.

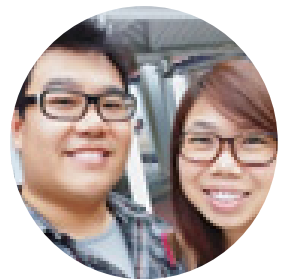
Leave this on your windscreen so the driver of the blocked car can contact you. Check your phone regularly to ensure you are not preventing someone from moving his or her car.

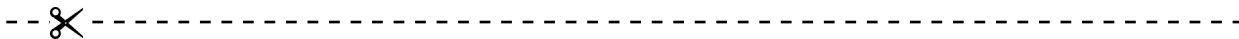
