Defensive Pistol for Women

On Saturday April 2, 2022 at 3 pm in Membership Hall we will be hosting a special training program for women. It will be open to the public, but its focus is providing our membership women and or spouses / guests with a special program on how to handle defensive situations with a pistol. Jim McCarthy, a club member, will be conducting the program. Jim is an Army helicopter pilot / Viet Nam veteran and a career veteran of the FBI special operations program. He has extensive training credentials, NRA certifications and work experience which makes him a perfect fit for this training. More information and notice will be provided but mark your calendar to make plans now to attend. You may bring the old guy, your main squeeze or significant gent but the program will be oriented for women. There is no charge or registration requirement.

Swap Market

We are launching our new online Swap Market. If you have any questions that are not answered here or at the October club meeting, email Scott Riggins at <u>dmscswap@riggins.net</u>. We want to soft-launch the Swap Market and then ramp up our usage. At first the items will only be visible to club members, but eventually we will make the items visible to the public. If you want to help us out and familiarize yourself with the process, please start with posting just a single item. Scott will then get back with each of you personally as we make sure the process is smooth and work out any kinks in the system.

Soon we will add these Swap Market links to the club web site. Submitting items is restricted to club members, so there is no reason to share the form link with anyone other than club members.

Some highlights of the initial launch:

* You will be able to create posts for things you want to sell, want to trade, want to acquire, or need help with.

* You should give at least a title and description of each item. It is recommended to also attach a photo, which you will be able to upload.

* Posted items will appear only to club members during soft-launch, but eventually available items will be visible to the public.

* You will be able to log in to see the items you have posted, or (during soft-launch) to see items others have posted. Scott can help you with this as needed.

* If you are interested in an item, you see posted, use the "I'm interested..." function on the site to tell us. This will create a message in the system, and Scott will connect you with the owner. Eventually we intend to make this connection process automatic, but Scott will be an intermediary in the early days of the Swap Market. (Which is why we want to start small, then ramp up) * You can also message Scott with general questions via the "I'm interested..." chat function. He may not always be able to answer immediately but the site records your chat message so he will get back with you either on the site chat and/or by email.

* The site will not handle money, delivery, or otherwise be party of the transaction. For the foreseeable future the site is essentially an electronic bulletin board to facilitate your person-to-person activity.

There is a lot more that could be said, and still more to come as we refine the process. Look for continued info in the newsletter, on the club web site, and at the club monthly meetings. We will have further info and a discussion at the October club member meeting.

Swap Meet / Programs – Sunday Afternoon at the Club

We held the last 2021 session on Sunday October 17. It is always on the 3rd Sunday at 2pm after the CMP shoot in Membership Hall. We do not have sessions planned for November and December due to the holidays. In October there were only two sellers, so we didn't set up to Swap. The planned program was *Getting Started in Reloading by Bruce Ungar*. There were only 7-8 members there, but we had a lively discussion on reloading which appeared to focus on crimping.

Bench Rest Matches

The 2021 program will be complete at the end of October. We had 16 shooters for the 100-yard competition. Look for results to be posted in the November newsletter. Mark Lofstead was the match director for this year. The 2021 match was for the period June thru September. It included center fire and rim fire rifles in one class. Thank you, Mark, for providing the leadership in supervising this competition.

In 2022 a separate rifle class is planned for 22 rf. The distance may be set at 50 yards for 2022 but details are still pending. The match director for 2022 is Cliff Abbio, he is an icon on the right side of the Marsico range in the early am. If you are interested in shooting in 2022 and have not shot in the 2021 program you can reach Cliff at <u>Cliffabbio@gmail.com</u>. This competition is typically shot in the warm months and ends in September. Depending upon shooter input the start may be in in April or May of 2022 but wait for more detail for the 2022 program to be announced by Cliff.

We are also going to add an Air Rifle Bench Rest shoot for 2022. This match program will include an indoor competition and an outdoor competition for 10 meters using the standard 10-meter target. There is a similar program run by the CMP in Ohio. Jeff Little and Mike Leone will run the shoot. We have planned two special programs for 2022. The plan is to try and hold an Eddie Eagle NRA youth training function early in the year.



DMSC is offering a course that will lead to becoming a certified Range Safety Officer. The course will be conducted on Sunday November 7, 2021, in the new clubhouse from 7AM until 5:30 PM. The class will cover a variety of topics relating to conducting and supervising safe shooting activities and range operations. The course consists of classroom instruction, individual practice to conduct safety briefings, practical experience with range operations, firearms stoppages, and malfunctions, as well as firearms familiarization. The course will last 9 hours, and participants are required to complete an open book test with a 90% passing score.

The cost will be \$40 for club members and \$95 for non-members. This includes the cost of instruction, course material, lunch, and refreshments. Additional costs will also need to be paid to the NRA for processing and maintaining certification.

Space is limited to 12 slots and will be filled on a first come – first served basis.

NEVER handle firearms while someone is down range.

ALWAYS wear proper eye and ear protection at the range.

DMSC Conducts Safety Reviews

Range Safety Officers (RSOs) will conduct random membership checks and safety reviews. RSOs will meet with members and guests while at the firing range. Membership ID's will be checked, and a copy of the range rules will be made available. It is important for all members to review safe gun handling procedures and to focus on the safety rules for each range used. The RSOs will be a wearing a distinctive safety vest or hat and will only ask for a few minutes of your time. Guests and Visitors are subject to the same rules as members. Violators will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from club grounds and termination of membership.
