### GOOD SHEPHERD MASKING STATUS



Per the CDC, people, including children older than 2, should wear a mask in indoor public places if they are:

Please wear a mask while in the public areas of the building. Masks may be removed in certain areas/ rooms indicated by signage or by the consensus agreement of those present.







# Feast of St. Francis and Laudato Si by Pope Francis



### The Important Things to Watch For

Be concerned about who your children are talking to online, the friends that they are hanging out with, and the people you invite into your home.

Be aware of subtle changes in your child's life. Grades at school, self-injury, dressing in a manner that is not weather appropriate, secrecy surrounding social media posts or on-line conversations.

Just because you see one or two of these things does not mean that your child is being abused or trafficked. Rather, these are simply keys that you and your child might need more help to understand the situation and open the gateway for communication. No matter what your child has been through or might share, they need to know that nothing will change your love for them.
