

Central Ohio Audiences might recognize Joe from his award-winning turns in the CATCO productions of The Christmas Schooner, Daddy Long Legs, I Do! I Do!, Dirty Rotten Scoundrels, Forbidden Broadway's Greatest Hits and Evil Dead: The Musical. Joe performed the role of Thomas in the 2012 regional premiere of The Story of My Life. Joe has collaborated on over 200 theatrical productions across the United States as an award-winning Actor, Director, Educator


and Producer. In addition to his current position as Theater Supervisor for the City of Dublin, Ohio (Abbey Theater of Dublin), he is also the Founder and Managing Director of New Albany Youth Theatre, and a Creative Consultant for both Broadway2LA Acting Studio and Evolution Theatre Company. Previous Theatrical stops include: CATCO (Associate Producing Director), Franklinton Preparatory Academy (Theater Instructor), The Phoenix Theatre for Children (Production Coordinator), Wayside Theatre (Assistant Artistic Director) and Act Out Productions (Associate Producer for the inaugural Columbus National Gay and Lesbian Theatre Festival). Joe is a passionate advocate for new theatrical works. He is the creator of the Abbey Theater of Dublin's Virtual Theatre Project, co-founder of the Otterbein Playwrights Collective and served for six years as the Program Coordinator for the Greater Columbus Arts Council (GCAC) Playwriting Fellowship Program. Joe is a member of Actors' Equity Association (AEA), a member of the Musical Theatre Educators' Alliance (MTEA) and an associate member of the Stage Directors and Choreographer Society (SDC). 


Matt Clemens (ALVIN KELBY) Matt Clemens returns to Columbus after a 7-year hiatus to perform with his friend, Joe Bishara, who returns to the stage after an absence of 3 years. This will be the fourth time the acclaimed actors have performed together, previously appearing in *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels, Chess in Concert,* and *Two Men and a Piano*. As musical director and actor they have collaborated in *Evil Dead: The Musical, Gray Gardens* (Matt also directed), *The Story of My Life,* and *Forbidden Broadway: Volume 1* (Joe also directed). As director and musical director, they have collaborated on *I*

Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change; A Christmas Carol, and Hairspray. Matt has performed on Broadway in Les Miserables in New York and toured for seven years with the Broadway National Tour of Les Miserables. As dance captain and a swing, he performed the show over 3000 times in New York and across the United States and Canada. In Columbus, Ohio, Matt performed in Follies in Concert (Short North Stage), Souvenir (CATCO), Chess in Concert (SRO Theatre Company), Dirty Rotten Scoundrels (CATCO), and Sunday in the Park with George (Short North Stage). He also directed Gray Gardens and Forever Plaid for CATCO as well as The Marvelous Wonderettes and A Grand Night for Singing for Short North Stage. Working in theater for over 30 years as an actor, singer, conductor, pianist, music director, composer, director, and writer, Matt currently writes, designs, and directs shows for Celebrity Cruises, based in Miami, Florida. BRIAN HILL - BOOK WRITER



Brian's work with composer/lyricist Neil Bartram includes the book for *The Story of My Life* (Broadway – 4 Drama Desk Award nominations including Outstanding Book and Outstanding Musical), *Something Wicked This Way Comes* (11 Barrymore Award nominations), the internationally popular *The Theory of Relativity* and the upcoming stage adaptation of *Bedknobs & Broomsticks*. Other works include the English language adaptation of *Les Belles-Soeurs*, a one-woman musical *You Are Here* and a fresh take on *The Adventures of Pinocchio*. He wrote the new book for the Old Globe's production of NBCUniversal's *October Sky* and the revised book for the Goodman Theatre's acclaimed production of *Brigadoon*.

Directing credits include work with Chicago Shakespeare Theater, The Segal Centre, Goodspeed Musicals and The Stratford Festival of Canada. For Disney Theatrical Productions he was resident director of the Toronto and Broadway companies of *The Lion King* and associate director of Broadway's *The Little Mermaid*.

The Story of My Life and The Theory of Relativity are licensed by Music Theatre International. The Adventures of Pinocchio is licensed through Concord Theatricals.

Brian is a Member of the Stage Directors and Choreographers Society and the Dramatists Guild and is on the faculty of New York University, Tisch School of the Arts.

NEIL BARTRAM - COMPOSER/LYRICIST



Born in the UK, raised in Canada and now based in New York City, Neil is the composer and lyricist of Broadway's The Story of My Life with book writer Brian Hill (4 Drama Desk Award nominations including Outstanding Music and Outstanding Lyrics). His musical The Theory of Relativity, written specifically for and about college age students, had its US premiere at Goodspeed Musicals in 2015 with its Off-West End premiere in the same year. Other works include an adaptation of Carlo Collodi's The Adventures of Pinocchio, a musical adaptation of Michel Tremblay's Les Belles-Soeurs, a musical based on Ray Bradbury's classic novel Something Wicked This Way Comes (11 Barrymore Award nominations), You Are Here, Senza Luce and the upcoming stage version of Disney's beloved film Bedknobs & Broomsticks. Neil's new score for Shakespeare in Love was written for the Chicago Shakespeare Theater and Asolo Rep productions.

Neil's awards include the ASCAP Foundation's Yellen Award, a Jonathan Larson Foundation Award, a Dramatists Guild Fellowship and a Dora Award.

The Story of My Life and The Theory of Relativity are licensed worldwide through Music Theatre International and The Adventures of Pinocchio is licensed through Concord Theatricals. Cast albums include The Story of My Life and The Theory of Relativity (both on PS Classics).

Neil is a member of the Dramatists Guild, ASCAP and is an alumnus of the BMI Lehman Engel Music Theatre Workshop. He is published by Warner/Chappell Music.

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
