THOUGHTS TO CONSIDER

From a writing by Saint Vincent de Paul, priest.

Serving the poor is to be our first preference

Even though the poor are often rough and unrefined, we must not judge them from external appearances nor from the mental gifts they seem to have received. On the contrary, if you consider the poor in the light of faith, then you will observe that they are taking the place of the Son of God who chose to be poor. Although in his passion he almost lost the appearance of a man and was considered a fool by the Gentiles and a stumbling block by the Jews, he showed them that his mission was to preach to the poor: *He sent me to preach the good news to the poor. We also ought to have this same spirit and imitate Christ's actions, that is, we must take care of the poor, console them, help them, support their cause.*

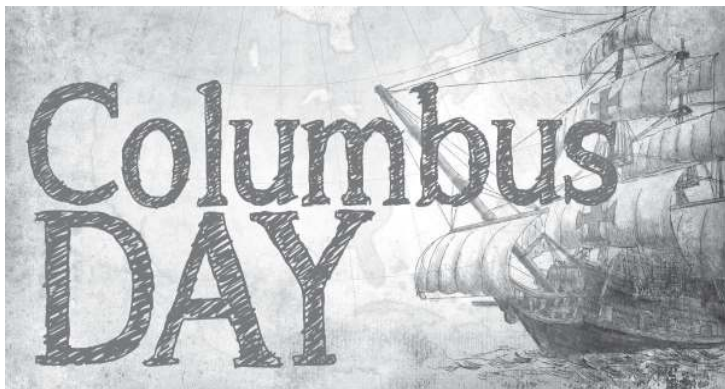
Since Christ willed to be born poor, he chose for himself disciples who were poor. He made himself the servant of the poor and shared their poverty. He went so far as to say that he would consider every deed which either helps or harms the poor as done for or against himself. Since God surely loves the poor, he also loves those who love the poor. For when one person holds another dear, he also includes in his affection anyone who loves or serves the one he loves. That is why we hope that God will love us for the sake of the poor. So when we visit the poor and needy, we try to understand the poor and weak. We sympathize with them so fully that we can echo Paul's words: *I have become all things to all men. Therefore, we must try to be stirred by our neighbors' worries and distress. We must beg God to pour into our hearts sentiments of pity and compassion and to fill them again and again with these dispositions.*

It is our duty to prefer the service of the poor to everything else and to offer such service as quickly as possible. If a needy person requires medicine or other help during prayer time, do whatever has to be done with peace of mind. Offer the deed to God as your prayer. Do not become upset or feel guilty because you interrupted your prayer to serve the poor. God is not neglected if you leave him for such service. One of God's works is merely interrupted so that another can be carried out. So when you leave prayer to serve some poor person, remember that this very service is performed for God. Charity is certainly greater than any rule. Moreover, all rules must lead to charity. Since she is a noble mistress, we must do whatever she commands. With renewed devotion, then, we must serve the poor, especially outcasts and beggars. They have been given to us as our masters and patrons.

CONSIDERANDO TU ESPENSAMIENTOS

De los escritos de san Vicente de Paúl, presbítero
EL SERVICIO A LOS POBRES HA DE SER PREFERIDO A
TODO

Nosotros no debemos estimar a los pobres por su apariencia externa o su modo de vestir, ni tampoco por sus cualidades personales, ya que, con frecuencia, son rudos e incultos. Por el contrario, si consideráis a los pobres a la luz de la fe, os daréis cuenta de que representan el papel del Hijo de Dios, ya que él quiso también ser pobre. Y así, aun cuando en su pasión perdió casi la apariencia humana, haciéndose necio para los gentiles y escándalo para los judíos, sin embargo, se presentó a éstos como evangelizador de los pobres: Me ha enviado para anunciar el Evangelio a los pobres. También nosotros debemos estar imbuidos de estos sentimientos e imitar lo que Cristo hizo, cuidando de los pobres, consolándolos, ayudándolos y apoyándolos. Cristo, en efecto, quiso nacer pobre, llamó junto a sí a unos discípulos pobres, se hizo él mismo servidor de los pobres, y de tal modo se identificó con ellos, que dijo que consideraría como hecho a él mismo todo el bien o el mal que se hiciera a los pobres. Porque Dios ama a los pobres y, por lo mismo, ama también a los que aman a los pobres ya que, cuando alguien tiene un afecto especial a una persona, extiende este afecto a los que dan a aquella persona muestras de amistad o de servicio. Por esto, nosotros tenemos la esperanza de que Dios nos ame, en atención a los pobres. Por esto, al visitarlos, esforcémonos en cuidar del pobre y desvalido, compartiendo sus sentimientos, de manera que podamos decir como el Apóstol: Me he hecho todo a todos. Por lo cual, todo nuestro esfuerzo ha de tender a que, conmovidos por las inquietudes y miserias del prójimo, roguemos a Dios que infunda en nosotros sentimientos de misericordia y compasión, de manera que nuestros corazones estén siempre llenos de estos sentimientos. El servicio a los pobres ha de ser preferido a todo, y hay que prestarlo sin demora. Por esto, si en el momento de la oración hay que llevar a algún pobre un medicamento o un auxilio cualquiera, id a él con el ánimo bien tranquilo y haced lo que convenga, ofreciéndolo a Dios como una prolongación de la oración. Y no tengáis ningún escrúpulo ni remordimiento de conciencia si, por prestar algún servicio a los pobres, habéis dejado la oración; salir de la presencia de Dios por alguna de las causas enumeradas no es ningún desprecio a Dios, ya que es por él por quien lo hacemos. Así pues, si dejáis la oración para acudir con presteza en ayuda de algún pobre, recordad que aquel servicio lo prestáis al mismo Dios. La caridad, en efecto, es la máxima norma, a la que todo debe tender: ella es una ilustre señora, y hay que cumplir lo que ordena. Renovemos, pues, nuestro espíritu de servicio a los pobres, principalmente para con los abandonados y desamparados, ya que ellos nos han sido dados para que los sirvamos como a señores.



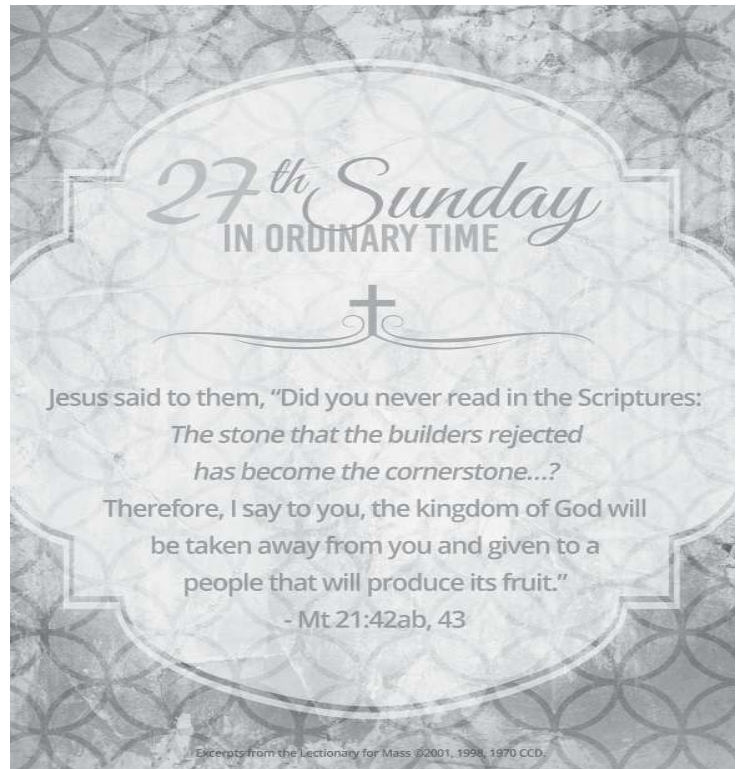

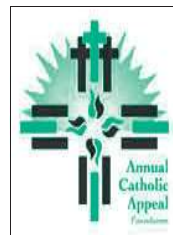

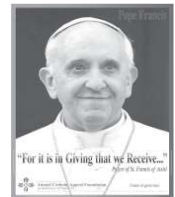
