Safe Re-Opening Recap from County of San Diego

Safe Reopening

The state created a new system to determine when and how activities can reopen. Details for each county are in its <u>Blueprint for a Safer Economy</u>. Recent changes for San Diego County are below.

To operate under the new guidance, businesses and organizations will need to update their Safe Reopening Plan.

Under the state guidance, the following can operate indoors with modifications starting Aug. 31. In some cases, guidance includes maximum capacity. They can continue outdoor operations.

- Restaurants, dine-in. 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is lower.
- Places of worship. 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is lower.
- Movie theaters. 25% capacity or 100 people, whichever is lower.
- Museums. 25% capacity.
- Gyms and fitness centers. 10% capacity.
- Dance studios. 10% capacity.
- Yoga studios. 10% capacity.
- Zoos and aquariums. 25% capacity.
- Hair salons and barbershops
- Nail salons
- Body waxing
- Tattoo parlors
- Piercing

Ocean Beach Town Council Back-To-School Supply Drive

The Ocean Beach Town Council through their OBthrives committee supported local families as they take on the challenge of home-based, virtual learning. When OBTC Board Member Stephanie Logan learned Ocean Beach Elementary students would not have access to basic school supplies this year due to Covid-19 quarantine restrictions, she decided something needed to be done.

Local entrepreneur and Ocean Beach Elementary Alumni Steve Yeng contributed a generous \$8,000 grant, along with donations from Carter Moss of Newbreak Church, Christie and Tony Romano, Raglan Public House, Bev and George McCalla and the Ocean Beach Woman's Club.

With funding in place, the OBthrives committee spearheaded by Stephanie Wilcox Kane, went to work locating, purchasing and assembling a whopping 480 Back-to-School Kits, each packed with all the essential supplies. Kits were distributed from the Ocean Beach Woman's Club on August 22nd. Well done!
