I grew up showing my parents Scotties and was showing in the Best in Show ring by the time I was 12. I worked with a professional handler as a teenager and showed many different breeds. At 16, I brought some of the first show Bouviers



into Canada. After marriage, my husband Ron and I continued to breed and show Scottish Terriers and Bouviers and when our oldest son wanted his own breed we added Wire Fox Terriers to the kennel. We have produced top ranked, specialty winning dogs in each of these breeds and they have been successful in many countries.

I started judging in 2000 and have judged National specialties and all breed shows in many countries around the world including Canada, USA, Wales, Ireland, Poland, Italy, Slovenia, Hungary, France, Australia & New Zealand. I have had the honor of judging at some prestigious shows including: Montgomery County Kennel Club, Great Western Terrier Association and the Italian Terrier Specialty

I am also an artist and illustrator and have illustrated the guide for the Scottish Terrier Club of America, the Canadian Scottish Terrier Club and the Victoria Scottish Terrier Club of Australia. I have done illustrations for several other breed clubs as well.

I have enjoyed dogs and dog shows my entire life and continue to enjoy them today.

Panel of Judges (cont'd)

MR WALTER PINSKER

Mr. Pinsker and his wife Monika started to breed and show Boxers under the "Mephisto" prefix in 1969. They produced well over 100 champions in that breed, who in turn have been awarded Best in Show wins over 150 times among them. They produced the No. 1 Boxer in Canada as well as No. 1 All Breed dog in Japan. Mr. Pinsker and his wife also have



owned/bred/exhibited Smooth Fox Terriers, Shiba Inus, Whippets and Akitas. Mr. Pinsker started to judge in 1978 and has been licensed to judge all breeds since 1990. Mr. Pinsker has adjudicated all over the world, such as the USA, Canada, Mexico, South Africa, Argentina, Brazil, Peru, Columbia, Thailand, Taiwan, Hong Kong, Philippines, Japan, Venezuela, Sweden, Australia, New Zealand, India and Norway.

MR CHARLES E TROTTER

All-breed judge from Carmel, CA, began his dog-showing career in his home state of Tennessee in 1958 with Afghan Hounds and later German Shepherd Dogs. His homebred Afghans were specialty winners and group winners before he became an all-breed professional handler and concentrated on the dogs of others. He was the zone representative for the Professional Handlers Association of America before his retirement from handling in 1979 when he began his judging career. Judging assignments have taken Chuck to six continents and all 50 American states. He has judged numerous times at Westminster, including the 1997 Working Group, and AKC's Eukanuba Invitational. He selected the BIS winner at the 2006 Eukanuba show held in Argentina.

Well-known for his knowledge of canine movement and anatomical structure, Trotter credits his background in German Shepherd Dogs, Afghans and Norwegian Elkhounds with his theories of proper conformation. Trotter's knowledge and appreciation of correct front-end assembly is legendary. Trotter was the judge of choice for a 21st Century German Shepherd Specialty of more than 100 dogs recently in Beijing.

Panel of Judges (cont'd)

He is a lifetime member (more than 50 years) of the Nashville Kennel Club and has served two lengthy terms as its president and as an on-going board member as well as show chairman. Chuck retired as president of Mid-South Home Exteriors in 2005 and found that retirement left him busier than ever! For when he is not judging dog shows, he enjoys his motorcycle as well as Laguna Seca activities, NASCAR racing , fishing and hunting.

MRS PATRICIA TROTTER

Patricia Craige Trotter registered her first litter of Vin-Melca Norwegian Elkhounds in 1951 and her most recent litter this year. Her breeding program has produced the Top Sire and Dam in the breed's history as well as the breed's top winners. Vin-Melca Elkhounds have won an incredible 10 Hound Group firsts at Westminster, all owner-handled.



When Ch. Vin-Melca's Vagabond became Top Dog All Breeds in 1970, he was the first amateur handled dog to achieve that honor. Pat handled her own dogs to Top Ten All Breed status on 10 different occasions while holding down a full-time teaching job. Her Elkhounds were regular winners of Top Hound honors and Quaker Oats awards.

Names such as Vagabond, Howdy Rowdy, Nimbus, Smuggler, Calista, Bombardier, Marketta, Silver Shadow, Top O' The Mark, Margretta, Voyager and the current campaigner The Norseman are amongst the legendary hounds produced by Trotter. Thirty-five different Elkhounds carrying the Vin-Melca name accumulated all-breed BIS honors to date. Today's dogs represent untold generations descending from that 1951 litter.

Pat's achievements began early in her life when Gaines bestowed their Girl Show Dog Fancier of the Year title in 1952. Winkie Awards included numerous honors as Breeder of the Year and Owner-Handler of the Year repeatedly in her campaigning years, and AKC selected her as Hound Group Breeder of the Year in 2004. Other honors include the Hall of Fame (originally Quaker Oats- now ProPlan), and two Fido awards as Dog Woman of the Year and Dog Writer of the Year.

Panel of Judges (cont'd)

Pat's 34 years teaching 8th grade American history in Carmel, California prepared her for her seminar work with presentations based on her book **Born To Win**. As an AKC Better Breeding columnist, she won the Dog Writers Award for a regular column in an all breed magazine in 1997.

As a judge Pat focuses on the belief that the true purpose of the dog show is to select breeding stock. By working in concert with each other, breeders and judges can cooperate to contribute to the continued improvement of the breed. She judged the 2009 Westminster Hound Group and will judge the 2012 Best Bred By in Show at the AKC/Eukanuba Invitational. She is justly proud that two Vin-Melca bred Elkhounds have won BBE Eukanuba Hound Groups (2008 and 2010) and a third BBE Eukanuba group winner was Vin-Melca sired.

EVENT REGISTRATION NUMBER (Foreign Born/Foreign Owned Dog)

For the purpose of entering CKC events to obtain Championship status and Obedience Titles and Degrees, individual registration is no longer required for foreign born, foreign owned dogs. Foreign exhibitors may apply for an ERN (Event Registration Number). *This number MUST be applied for within 30 days of obtaining points at a CKC event to avoid cancellation.* Exhibitors may submit a photocopy of dogs' foreign Registration Certificate and the appropriate fee (\$55.85 Canadian Funds) along with a letter of request to the CKC. (This ERN number replaces a CKC Individual Registration Number for entering CKC events ONLY.)

CONFORMATION CLASSES

The following Regular CKC Classes (divided by sex) will be offered

<u>JUNIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog **6** months of age and under **9** months of age on the day of the show

<u>SENIOR PUPPY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog **9** months of age and under **12** months of age on the day of the show

<u>12 TO 18 MONTH CLASS</u> – This class shall be for any dog 12 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the show

CANADIAN BRED CLASS - This class shall be for any dog born in Canada.

(Champions of any country excluded)

BRED BY EXHIBITOR CLASS - This class shall be for any dog owned and handled in the ring owner/breeder. The handler <u>MUST</u> be the owner/co-owner <u>AND</u> breeder/co-breeder of the dog. The owner/breeder must handle the dog at the class level, but need not handle the dog for further awards

OPEN CLASS - This class shall be for all dogs

<u>SPECIALS ONLY CLASS</u> - This class shall be for any dog which has a recorded CKC Registration or Event Registration Number and has attained the required points for Championship status. <u>Note</u>: A Listed dog <u>MAY</u> be moved to the Specials Only Class after the closing of entries, provided the CKC Individual or Event Registration Number was received prior to the first day of the show. The request to move a class dog to the Specials Only Class <u>MUST</u> be received by the Show Secretary ONE HOUR PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE SHOW ON THE DAY CONCERNED. Listing Fees <u>WILL NOT</u> be refunded

EXHIBITION ONLY - All dogs entered in this class shall be listed in the catalogue with the same particulars as dogs entered in regular competition. Dogs entered in this class **<u>MAY NOT COMPETE</u>** in any Regular class but may enter and compete in Non-Regular classes and/or Parades ONLY

NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(if offered by the club, refer to individual Premium List) <u>NOTE</u>: Any dog entered in a Non-Regular class MUST also be entered in a regular class or for Exhibition Only on the same day, dogs being entered in a Parade may be spayed, neutered or in an unorthodox trim PROVIDED they are entered in Exhibition Only







EXTRACTS FROM THE CONFORMATION SHOW RULES & REGULATIONS

CHAPTER 4.1.3 - JUDGES

A judge officiating at a show held under these rules shall not be subjected to any indignities of any kind during the progress of the show, and it shall be the duty and obligation of the club holding the show to see this rule is effectively enforced.

CHAPTER 8 - ENTRIES and ENTRY FEES

Section 8.3.1

Every dog entered in Championship Shows held under these rules must be registered, have an Event Registration Number, eligible for registration with the CKC or have a CKC Miscellaneous Class Certification number issued by the CKC Chief Registrar. If a dog is not registered individually in the CKC it may be entered at a show, held under these rules, as a "listed" dog, provided

(a) it is not a Miscellaneous breed

(b) if born in Canada, is eligible for individual registration

(c) if foreign born and owned, an Event Registration Number or CKC registration number is obtained from the CKC within 30 days of the first show entered.

A listing fee of \$9.40 must accompany the entry of a "listed" dog at a show held under these rules.

Section 8.2:

INCOMPLETE ENTRIES

Entry forms which are incomplete or those that contain incorrect information after the closing date of entries will be void and under no circumstances can changes be made. Any dog taking a win resulting from such an entry will result in the wins being cancelled.

Section 8.6.2:

DISHONORED CHEQUES

Tendering of a dishonored cheque or credit card in payment of entry fees shall be considered non-payment of entry fees.Clubs may refuse to accept entries from any exhibitor who have been known to tender dishonored cheques in payment of entry fees unless such entries are accompanied by a money order, cash or certified cheque.

CHAPTER 14 - DISQUALIFICATION

Section 14.1.4

A dog once disqualified for any reason at a Championship show held under these rules cannot again be shown or entered at a show held under these rules unless and until said dog has been reinstated by the CKC. All awards earned by a dog shown in violation of this section will be cancelled by the CKC and the owner of said dog is subject to disciplinary action. Note: for any further information on reinstatement refer to Chapter 14, Section 3 of the Conformation Show Rules and Regulations

CHAPTER 5 - SHOW OFFICIALS

Section 5.1.5

A show-giving club will be held responsible during the show for the conduct of exhibitors and spectators. Any person acting in an abusive or objectionable manner must be removed from the show on complaint to the Show Superintendent.

AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that I (we), all exhibitors, handlers and patrons, know and abide by the "CKC Dog Show Rules", and that I am (we are) familiar with their content. I (we) agree that the Club holding this show has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the Club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of the Show and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the Auld Lang Syne Dog Association, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of a dog while in or upon the show premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim, and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss of a dog by disappearance, theft, death or otherwise, and from any claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury be caused or alleged to be caused by the negligence of the Club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other cause or causes.

I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show, howsoever such injuries, death or damage to property may be caused and whether or not the same may have been caused and whether or not the same may have alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other person.
