Bidding Process for Oktoberfest 2021 Silent Auction

The bidding process is a blind bidding process, and bids can be submitted in person, via email or via mail.

In Person Bidding will take place at both St. Edward's Campus and Christ Campus. Paper Bidding sheets and a secure box in which to place the bid will be available at both Campuses.

Email Bidding: eBidding sheets will also be available (see eBidding sheet in Oktoberfest email). Complete the e-Bidding sheet and email it to Beth Drinan at beth3323@comcast.net. You can also submit a bid via email by providing your contact information, the Auction Item #, the Item Name and your bid amount.

Mail Bidding: Individuals can also "snail" mail a bid to Beth at the church office (206 N. Midland Ave. Joliet, IL 60435). This is similar to the email process – submit your bid by printing and completing the eBidding sheet or dropping a note that includes your contact information, the Auction Item #, the Item Name and your bid amount.

The minimum bid for each item is the value, which is noted in the description of each item. Bids above the value will be in increments of \$5 (if the value is under \$100) or \$10 (for any items \$100 or more).

The highest bid amount for each item will be shared through a weekly Oktoberfest Auction email. You may submit a new bid for an item, using the bidding methods noted above, if you would like to try to increase your bid for an item.

Bid Match

As an added incentive to increase your bids, a generous benefactor has offered to match the bid amount over the item's value up to \$1,000!!

So how does this work? Say that the item's value is \$75, and the winning bid is \$100, a difference of \$25 over the item's value. This difference of \$25 over the value will be matched, dollar for dollar, up to \$1,000.

Bidding will begin on Sunday, September 19 and it will close at midnight on Sunday, October 10. The bidding box will be removed after the services on October 10. All bids – whether via bidding sheets, email or snail mail must be completed and submitted before midnight on October 10.

If there is a tie for the highest bid on any basket/item, all bidders with that bid will be contacted by Beth so they can submit another, higher bid.

How will you know if your bid was the highest bid?

Those with the winning bids will be notified by Beth the week of October 11 and will also be announced in a special Oktoberfest Connections email.

Collecting Items and Payments: Once the winning bidders have been determined, Beth Drinan will contact them to arrange pick-up of the item. Payments may be made via check, payable to St. Edward and Christ (mail to the church office) or online via www.tithe.ly (search for St. Edward & Christ Joliet). Tithe.ly accepts credit card payments or a direct debit from your bank account. Select "Oktoberfest" as your giving option.

Purchase your Share the Wealth tickets before/after the 8:30 am services at St. Edward's Campus or 10:30 am services at Christ Campus starting September 19 through October 10. Tickets are \$5 each or 5 tickets for \$20. The winner will receive half of the ticket proceeds.
