OFFENSIVE OUTAGE: The Omaha Storm Chasers were held to six total baserunners in Sunday's series finale against the lowa Cubs, falling, 6-1, to finish the week with a series split against the l-Cubs. Omaha was held hitless for 6.1 innings until **INF Emmanuel Rivera** launched a solo home run to break up the no-hit bid and shutout. It was Rivera's 14th homer of the year, tying him with **INF Ryan McBroom** for the league lead. **RHP Jackson Kowar** allowed a season-high three runs on six hits in 3.2 innings in his first start since being optioned last Wednesday.

GETTING THE CALL: INF Emmanuel Rivera made his Major League debut on Monday against Boston, going 2-for-4, including collecting his first Major League hit on the first pitch of his first plate appearance. Rivera became the third Chasers to make his Major League debut this year, joining C Sebastian Rivero (5/8) and RHP Jackson Kowar (6/7), and the 66th Chasers alum to make his debut with Kansas City in the Storm Chasers era (2011-pres.). At the time of his promotion, Rivera led Triple-A East in RBIs (40) and XBH (26), was tied for first in HR (14), ranked second in runs (36), third in hits (50), and fourth in slugging percentage (.593) while batting .282/.337/.593 in 44 games with Omaha. LHP Richard Lovelady was recalled on Tuesday after posting a 1.08 ERA in seven appearances. He had not allowed a run or a hit in his last 8.0 innings, a streak that spanned five appearances.

CRUSHING IT AT CHS FIELD: The Chasers make their second trip to CHS Field this season after winning four of six games against the Saints in St. Paul from June 8-13. During those six games, Omaha outscored St. Paul 48-32, batting .327 (67-for-205) as a team while scoring eight runs per game and clubbing 16 home runs. Omaha recorded a season-high 16 runs on a season high 21 hits on 6/10 @ STP and finished the series with a modern franchise record seven home runs in a 15-4 win on 6/13 @ STP.

McBoom GOES THE DYNAMITE: INF/OF Ryan McBroom hit his 14th home run of the season on 6/20 vs. LOU, a mark that is tied for the league lead and is tied for fourth in all of Minor League Baseball. McBroom hit two home runs in the series against Louisville from 6/15-6/20 after smashing four home runs—including a three-homer game on 6/13 @ STP—during the series in St. Paul from 6/8-6/13. McBroom did not hit a home run in six games played against lowa from 6/23-6/27, the first series this season McBroom has failed to hit at least one home run. In 12 games against St. Paul this season, McBroom is batting .333 (16-for-48) with five home runs and 11 RBIs. After hitting .218 (19-for-87) with seven home runs in 14 games in May, McBroom is batting .306 (26-for-85) with seven home runs in 20 games in June.

OLIVARES ON TOP: OF Edward Olivares has 17 multi-hit games in 32 games played with Omaha. After batting .395/.473/.654 in 20 games in May, Olivares is batting .327/.375/.519 through 12 games in June. Olivares leads the league in average (.368), ranks third on on-base percentage (.436) and slugging (.602), is tied for fourth in hits (49), and is tied for fifth in Triple-A East in steals (11) with fellow Chaser **OF Kyle Isbel**. Olivares has been recalled by Kansas City and optioned back to Omaha three times in the last month. He was initially recalled on 5/30, then optioned on 6/3, recalled again on 6/6, optioned again on 6/9, recalled once more on 6/14, and optioned back to Omaha on 6/17. In seven total games with Kansas City, Olivares has gone 6-for-23 (.292) with three runs scored and a stolen base.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 32-15 (.681), the Omaha Storm Chasers are tied with Tampa (32-15, .681) for the third-best record in Minor League Baseball, trailing Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (32-13, .711) and San Jose (33-15, .688). Omaha leads the Midwest Division by 7.0 games, the second-largest divisional lead in all of affiliated baseball behind Frsico (+9.0, Double-A Central). The Chasers have been in sole possesion of first place for 34 consecutive days (May 26-pres.).

HISTORIC HOMER PACE: The Storm Chasers lead Triple-A East and all of Minor League Baseball with 93 home runs in 47 games, just under two home runs per game. Omaha is on pace to hit 237 home runs in the 120-game season, which would break the franchise record of 231 set in 1999 (141 games). The 1999 team's 231 home runs in a season was a modern Pacific Coast League record until 2019, when El Paso hit 258 home runs in 140 games. If the 2021 season included all 142 initially-scheduled games, Omaha would be on pace for 284 homers. The Sacramento Solons hit 305 home runs in 1974 while playing home games in a converted football stadium with a left-field fence located 233 feet from home plate.

HOME RUN HEROES: The Chasers' 93 home runs are also more than 14 teams in Major League Basebal. Omaha has recorded at least one home run in 32 of its last 35 games and 39 of 47 games overall—including a 13-game homer streak from 5/16-6/1—and has recorded 23 multi-homer games, including three four-homer games, five five-homer games, and one seven-homer game. Omaha is 29-10 when hitting at least one home run this season.

FOR OMAHA: RHP Jakob Junis makes his fourth start with Omaha after allowing a season-high five hits in 2.1 innings on a season-high 56 pitches (41 strikeouts) in his outing in Game 1 of Wednesday's doubleheader (6/23) at lowa. Junis gave up three runs (two earned) on five hits, including the first home run he has allowed in three starts with Omaha. The right-hander pitched against St. Paul at CHS Field in his first start with Omaha this season, allowing three runs on three hits in 2.1 innings iwth four strikeouts and zero walks.

FOR ST. PAUL: RHP Yennier Cano makes his fourth apperarnce (first start) with St. Paul. He last pitched on 6/23 @ COL, striking out three and walking one in 2.0 scoreless innings. Cano has not pitched more than 2.0 innings in any of his three outing with St. Paul. He began the season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 1.47 ERA in 12 relief appearances (18.1 IP). RHP Rob Whalen is expected to pitch in relief of Cano.

- Began season with Kansas City, posting a 5.19 ERA in 15 appearances (five starts) with 35 strikeouts and 11 walks in 34.2 innings
- Recorded a 4.37 ERA in 22.2 innings as a starters (five starts) and a 6.75 ERA in 12.0 innings (12 appearances) as a reliever
- Began the 2020 season on the Injured List and made his season debut in the team's 10th game, ultimately making eight appearances (six starts) between two stints on the Injured List
- His final two appearances of 2020 were relief appearances, throwing a pair of scoreless innings on 9/23 vs. STL and 9/25 vs. DET and 10/25 vs. DET and 1
