

Dear Parents and Carers

Firstly, in these truly unprecedented times, I hope more than anything else that you and your family are all safe and well. I would also like to thank you for continuing to support your child with their learning over the past week.

During remote education students are required to continue to follow their school timetable. Students are expected to attend all of their lessons including tutor time each day.

On MS Teams students can access 'live lessons', classroom resources, home learning and communicate with their class teachers. Your child can access MS Teams on a laptop, tablet or mobile device. ***'Live lessons' are compulsory for all students.***

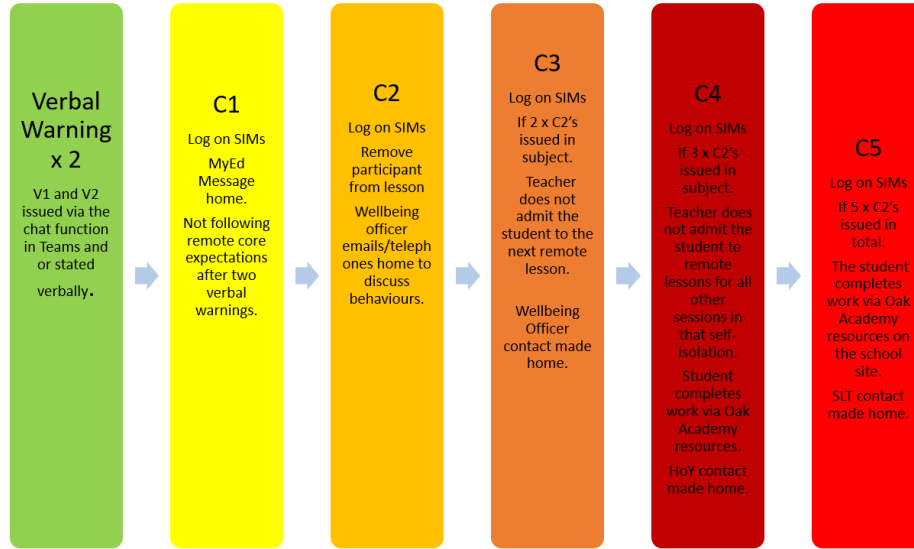
Students are expected to check their MS Teams digital classrooms daily to ensure they access all 'live learning' sessions and complete all assignments set.

When accessing 'live learning' students must behave appropriately.

- Mute microphone – the student should only unmute if they are given permission by their teacher
- Use the hands up function to ask a question
- Use the chat function to communicate about the learning ONLY

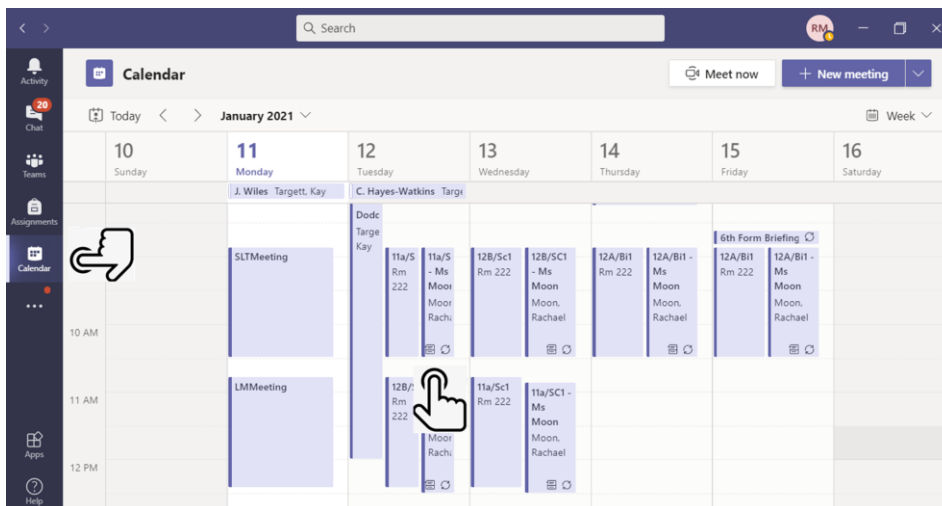
Students who are unable to meet academy expectations will be sanctioned in line with our remote learning behaviour flow map.

Academy Remote Learning Behaviour Flow Map

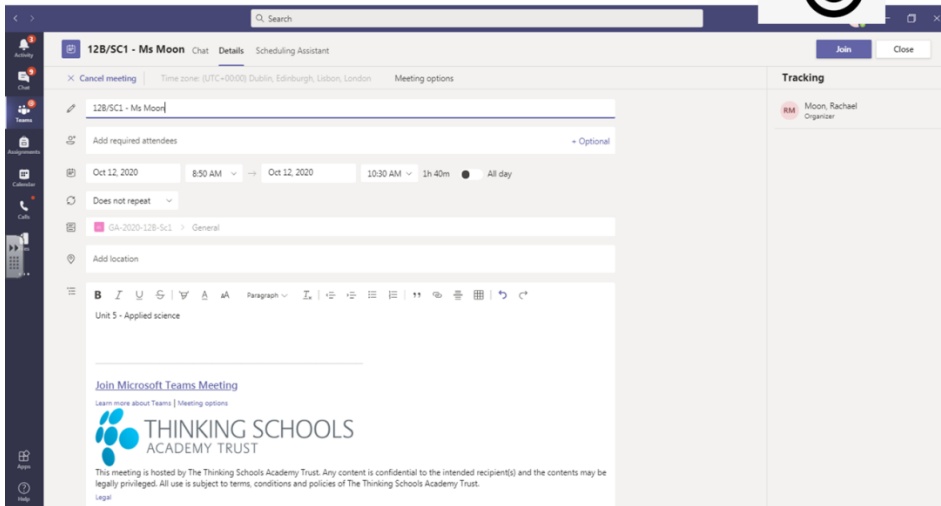


To access a lesson your child will be required to:

1. Look at their timetable and their MS Teams calendar to identify the lesson they should be attending.

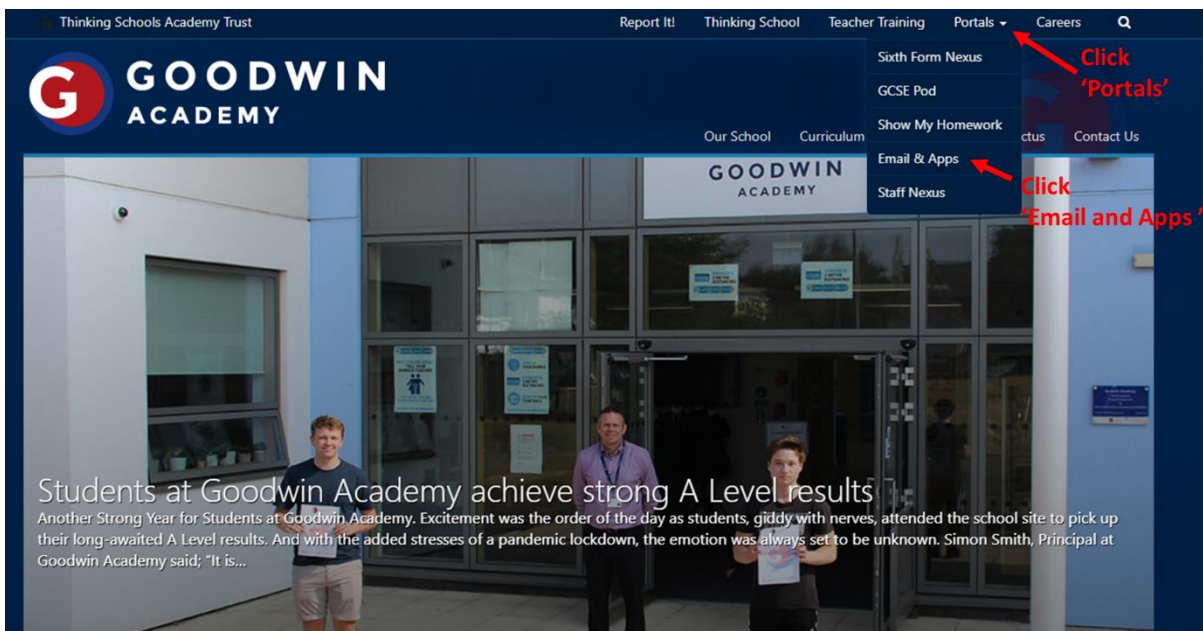


2. Click join meeting.



Students log into MS Teams using their school username and password. They can access MS Teams on a computer through MS 365 or via the school website.
