BIG NEWS!!! Mad City Quilt Guild is resuming in-person meetings later this month! The Middleton Community Church (our usual meeting location) is opening its doors, and we are welcome to meet there again.

Please note: Masks will be required at all times (except for the speaker). Social distancing will be at your discretion. We will open the windows when we can, to improve flow of fresh air.

Some changes to our traditional schedule: we are not having a holiday party this year. The April 5th afternoon meeting will be cancelled (it is election day, and the church is a polling place), but we are instead going to have a June picnic!

For the first meetings, instead of having speakers, we are focusing on Show and Tell: Sharing of mini quilts, block lotto blocks, fabric challenge quilts, community service quilts and all of the wonderful quilts you have made in the last 1.5 years.

We finally get to meet in person, after 17+ months!!!!

We -- **all** of us -- will be the **PROGRAMS** for the first two months. In the *first two meetings, Aug 23 and Sept 7*, we ask that you share your Expo mini-quilts (Home Sweet Home) and Fabric challenge quilts from 2019-2020. Gwen will re-present instructions for Barn Quilt Blotto blocks. *General show and tell*: 3-5 quilts per member; Tuesday afternoon quilts should be different from Monday evening's. Julayne will show Linus quilts.

Sept 27th and Oct 5th meetings will feature *drawings* for Barn Quilt blocks. (You could be a lucky winner! Prepare your entry now!) Show and tell will continue (same guidelines as above), plus Linus guilts.

Our first workshop will be presented by Jane Vaughan: **Pretzel Twist**, on Saturday, October 16; 9 am to 1 pm at the church; \$25. (Entry form enclosed.) We expect to reschedule workshops by Bill Hoernke on Bargello, and Mary Joy Johnson on 60° Triangles, later on. During the Oct 25th meeting, Kristin, our new interim president, will share her quilts and "story" -- "My Life in Quilting: A Gumdrop Retrospective."

Lots to look forward to. Whew. We're baaaacccckkkk!


