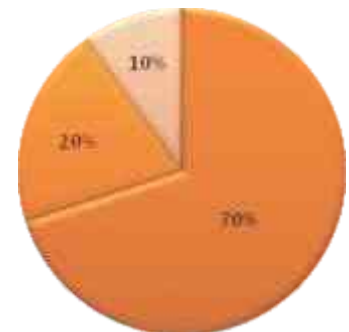
The segregation of methods to be used for training is following:
