"Living in Peace with Others" 1 Peter: The Transforming Epistle 1 Peter 3:8-12

Introduction

I. The Need for Living in Peace with Others

1 Peter 3:8-12 To sum up, all of you be harmonious, sympathetic, brotherly, kindhearted, and humble in spirit; not returning evil for evil or insult for insult, but giving a blessing instead; for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing. For, "The one who desires life, to love and see good days, Must keep his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking deceit. He must turn away from evil and do good; He must seek peace and pursue it. For the eyes of the Lord are toward the righteous, And His ears attend to their prayer, But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."

II. The Principles for Living in Peace with Others

Principle #1. Look for common ground.

1 Pet. 3:8 "...all of you be harmonious..."

Principle #2. Enter into the world of their feelings.

1 Pet. 3:8 "...all of you be....sympathetic..."

Principle #3. Treat all people as important.

1 Pet. 3:8 "...all of you be...brotherly..."

Principle #4. Be gutsy enough to forgive.

1 Pet. 3:8 "...all of you be...kindhearted..."

Principle #5. Stop looking out for number one.

1 Pet. 3:8 "...all of you be...humble in spirit..."

Principle #6. Don't bite back.

1 Pet. 3:9 "...not returning evil for evil, or insult for insult..."

Principle #7. Retaliate with a blessing.

1 Pet. 3:9 "...but giving a blessing instead..."

Principle #8. Muzzle your mouth.

1 Pet. 3:10 "The one who desires life, to love and see good days, Must keep his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking deceit." (cf. Prov. 18:4, 7, 21; James 3:8; Ps. 39:1; Ps. 141:3)

Principle #9. Swerve to avoid a collision.

1 Pet. 3:11 "He MUST TURN AWAY FROM EVIL..." (cf. Prov. 20:3; 17:14)

Principle #10. Do the right thing.

1 Pet. 3:11 "AND DO GOOD..." (cf. James 4:17; Gal. 6:9)

Principle #11. Be a peace-chaser.

1 Pet. 3:11b "He must seek peace and pursue it." (cf. Matt. 5:9; Heb. 12:14)

III. The Motivations for Living in Peace with Others

Motivation #1 - Living in peace with others is the natural response to God's supernatural blessing in our lives.

1 Pet. 3:9 "...for you were called for the very purpose that you might inherit a blessing." (cf. Ps. 34:12-17)

Motivation #2 - Living in peace with others is our ticket to a long and happy life.

1 Pet. 3:10 For, "The one who desires life, to love and see good days, Must keep his tongue from evil and his lips from speaking deceit..." (cf. Eccl. 2:17-18)

Motivation #3 - God's loving eyes are watching us.

1 Pet. 3:12 ""For the eyes of the Lord are toward the righteous..."

Motivation #4 - God's attentive ears are listening to us.

1 Pet. 3:12 "...And His ears attend to their prayer..." (cf. Ps. 34:15; Ps. 102:1)

Motivation #5 - God's angry face is set against us.

1 Pet. 3:12 "... But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil."

IV. The Challenge to Live in Peace with Others

Discussion Questions:


