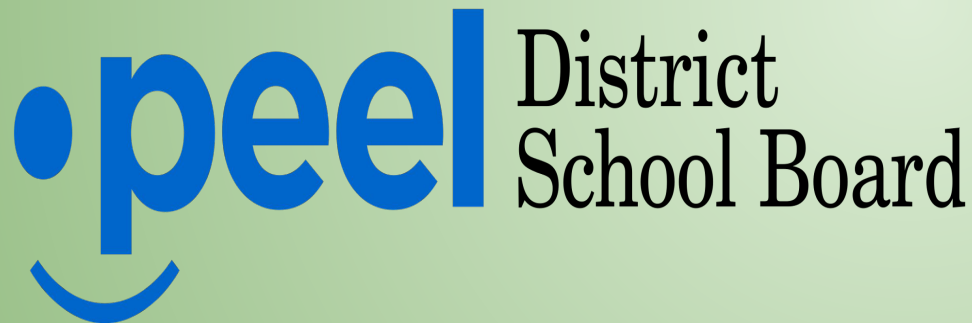

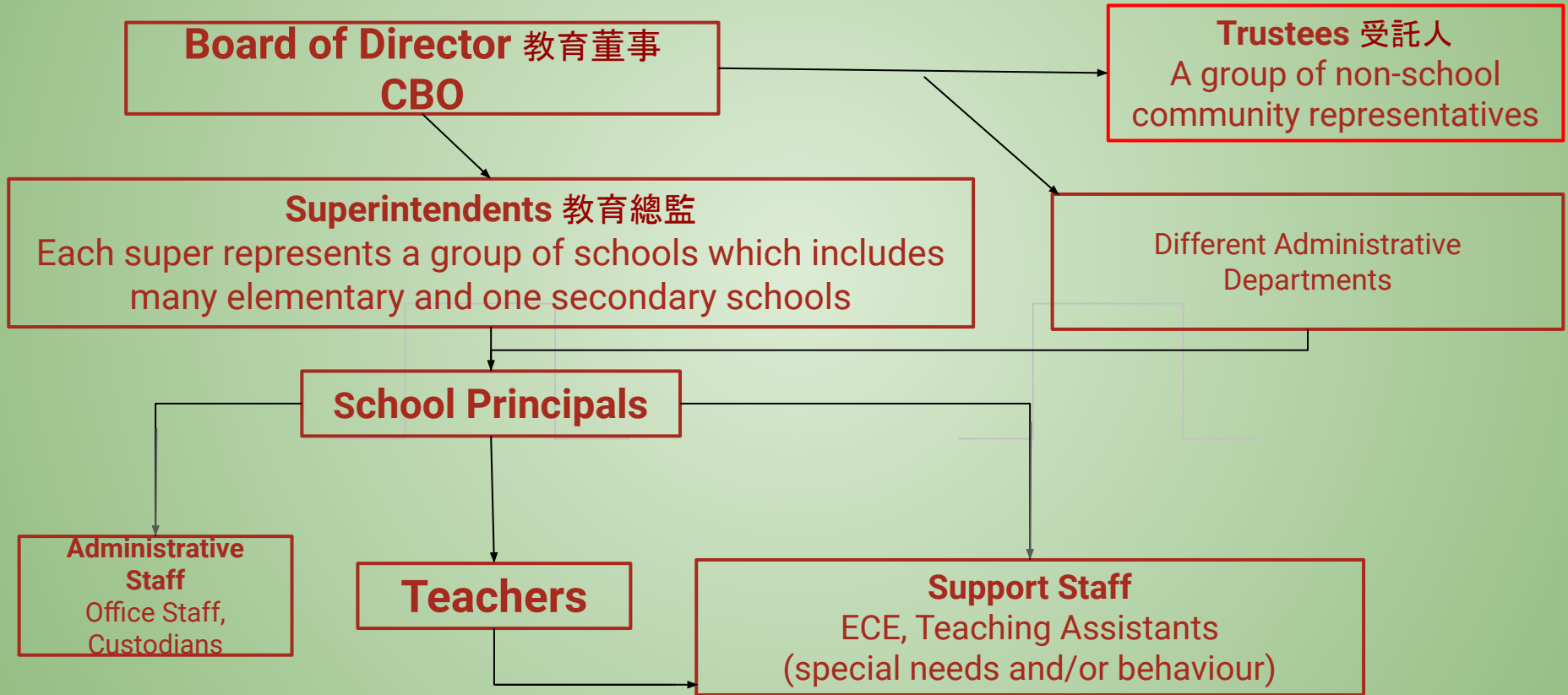

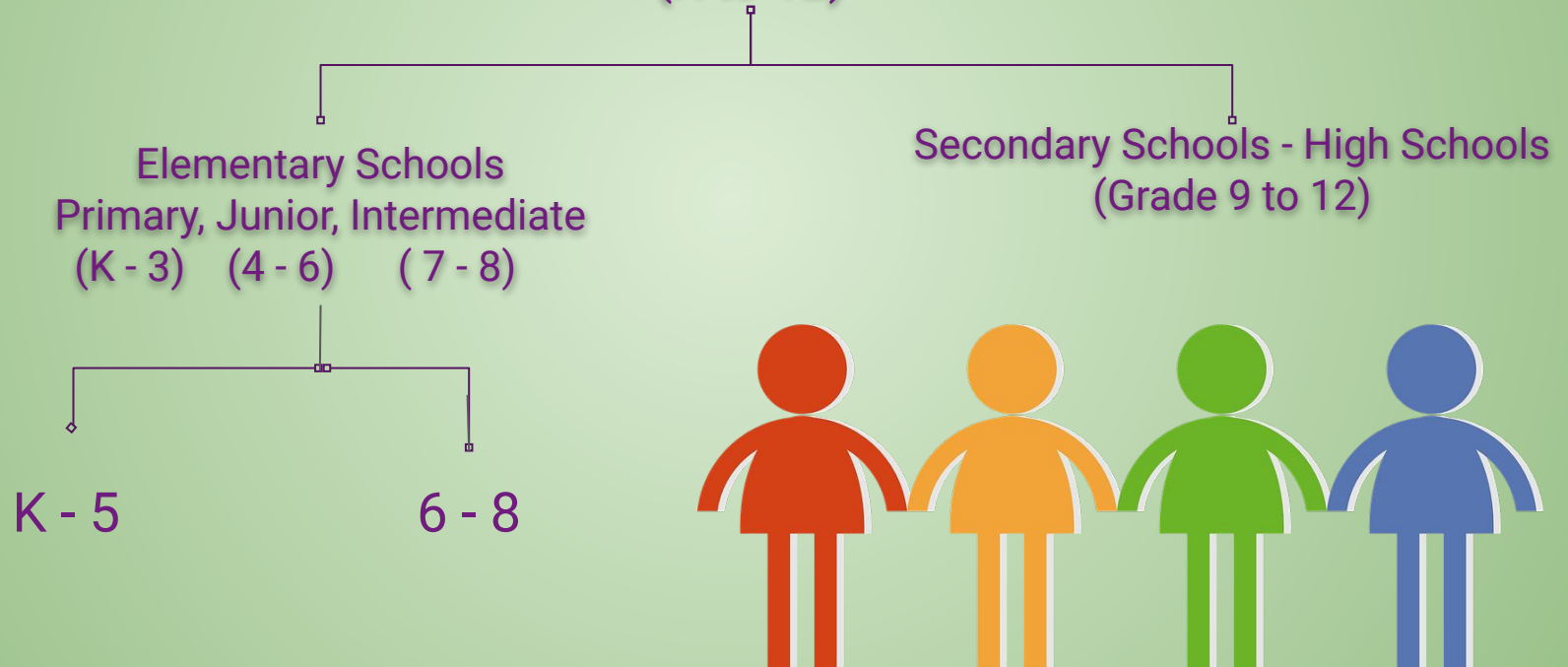


Divisions of Schools in Peel District School Board (PDSB)

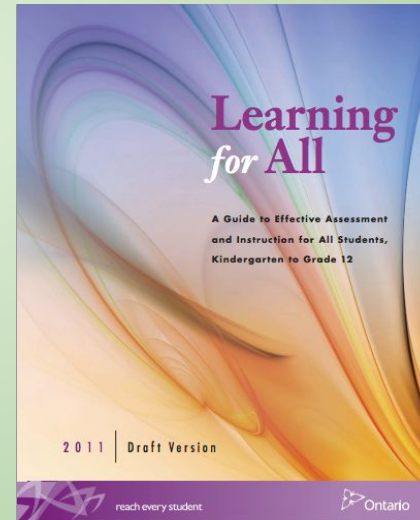
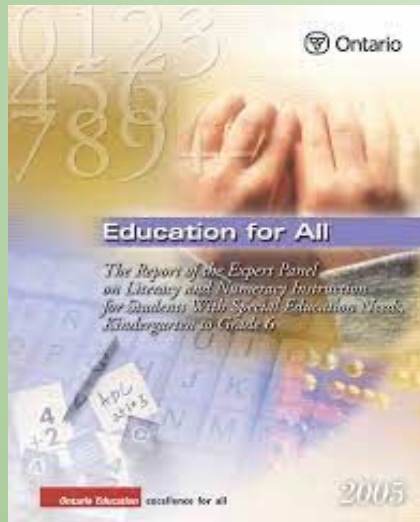

No retain in the same grade or skip a grade
(沒有留班/跳班)

Homework: from Grade 1 add 10 minutes as the grade goes up each year.
E.g., Grade 6 will have about 1 hour homework in average daily

Many different programs and opportunities
(不同的學校課程和機會) are offered throughout the 14 public school years

Focus on differentiated instructions
(不同的方式教學) and reach out to every kid in small groups and one-to-one formats

4 different standardized tests (標準化考試) throughout the 14 public school years

Grade 3 and 6 - Reading, Writing and Mathematics (Math) in May or June

Grade 9 - Mathematics (Test date varied each year)

Grade 10 - English Literacy (OSSLT) (英語讀寫能力測試) - must pass this before moving on to college or university, may take as many times as the student needs to pass at or above 75.0%.

Breakdown of Regional and In-School Support Programs

PDSB ESL/ELL - English Second Language/English Language Learner
英語作為第二語言

- Assessments by We Welcome the World Centres
(歡迎你中心英語第二語言教師 評估)
- Assessments by school ESL/ELL support teachers
- ESL/ELL daily withdrawal lessons by ESL/ELL support teachers
- In-class support with modifications by the class teacher.

PDSB Special Education

特殊教育

Students who have special needs academically, physically, psychologically and mentally

- All assessments except gifted are done by PDSB Education Psychologists, Speech and Language Therapists (教育心理學家, 言語和語言治療師等會做評估)
- Gifted, recommended by teachers, Canadian Cognitive Ability Test (CCAT), Grade 4 (老師推薦特別優質學生做這個測試)
- All these students will have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) throughout their school years (所有這些學生都將在整個學年制定個人教育計劃)
- This plan is reviewed and updated a few times a year with parents. (該計劃每年與家長一起審查和更新幾次.)

If the student is identified in one of the above special needs, the parents are provided 2 options

1. First option, special education self-contained classes - smaller classes (excepted gifted), 1 teacher with 1 to 3 Teaching Assistants (TAs)
2. For gifted, Enhanced Learning Class, class size is 20+ with 1 teacher teaching majority of the subjects in Grade 5 to 8. For high schools, 9 - 12, rotary format
3. All of the special need classes are combined grades by divisions
4. Second option, In-School Support Program (ISSP), classroom teachers and ISSP teachers differentiate and modify the student's education program, some need TA support in-class, some participate in withdrawal lessons by the ISSP teachers.

French Immersion, French Schools

French Immersion Programs:

- Grade 1 French Immersion
- Grade 7 Extended French

Half of all subjects will be taught in French

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

Total of 30 credits from Grade 9 to 12

Compulsory Credits (必須科目)

- 4 credits in one's first language (**English** or **French**) (from Grade 9 - 12, one credit per a year),
- 3 credits in **Mathematics**, with at least one credit in Grade 11 or 12,
- 2 credits in **Science**, one in Grade 9 and one in Grade 10,
- 1 credit in Grade 10 **Canadian History**,
- 1 credit in Grade 9 **Canadian Geography**,
- 1 credit in the **Arts** (visual art, music, dance and drama),
- 1 credit in **Health and Physical Education**,
- 1 credit in one's second language, either French or English,
- 0.5 credits in Grade 10 **Career** (職業) Studies, and
- 0.5 credits in Grade 10 **Civics** (社會公民)

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

Total of 30 credits from Grade 9 to 12

Additional provincial requirements:

One must also earn 1 credit from each of the following three areas:

- **Group 1 (語言和社會):** 1 additional credit in a second language (either French or English), an aboriginal language, a **classical** or **international language**, or **social sciences** and the **humanities**, or **canadian** and **World studies**, or **guidance and career education**, or **cooperative education***
- **Group 2 (體育和藝術):** 1 additional credit in health and **physical education**, or the **arts**, or **business studies**, or **cooperative education**.
- **Group 3 (科學):** 1 additional credit in **science** in Grade 11 or 12, or **technological education**, computer studies, or **cooperative education**.

Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

Total of 32 credits from Grade 9 to 12

In addition, students must also have completed:

- 18 compulsory credits
- 12 optional credits (4 of which may be obtained through approved dual-credit courses and coop),
- 40 hours of community service (社區服務),
- meet the provincial secondary school literacy requirement (EQAO Gr. 10 Literacy Test).

Information sessions of the pathway programs will be organized and provided by the schools in Grade 5 (some) and Grade 8.

Apply Post-Secondary Education (universities, colleges and trades)

University Admissions 大學取錄

- High school Academic Courses with a M or U in the course code
- The average of the highest 6 marks of Grade 12 credits 最高六科 科目的平均分
- Grade 12 English must be included in the top 6 marks
- Admission % varied, depends on the program from 70% to 90+%
- Consult with universities for requirements of different programs

Apply Post-Secondary Education (universities, colleges and trades)

College Admissions 專上學院取錄

- High school Applied Courses with a M or C in the course code
- Meet requirements of the program
- If it is a degree, require a minimum of six Grade 12 credits at the university and/or university/college level
- Grade 12 English must be included in the top 6 marks
- Grade 11 marks are sometimes considered
- No minimum entrance % but usually 60% and above
- Consult with colleges for requirements of different programs
