HOW WE KEEP AL-ANON UNITED

Lois writes in <u>LOIS REMEMBERS</u> about the early days of Al-Anon that as groups began to spring up they called themselves various names such as AA Auxiliary, Triple A, Non-Alcoholics Anonymous and AA Associates. As communication was not as easy as it is in this day and time, and often groups did their own thing Lois could see that some structure was necessary to keep the Al-Anon pro-

gram united and consistent. The World Service Office gradual began to publish the first Al-Anon literature, establish the structure and put into place the Twelve Steps and Twelve
