Opera Viva! offers a unique educational and travel experience. The program for young artists provides the perfect balance between classes, concert performances, planned events and independent exploration.

The program develops each voice through private lessons and coaching, classroom instruction in the Italian language, acting and stage directing, opera scenes and concert repertoire.

Masterclasses in sacred music, career preparation, musical theater performance and Alexander Technique are also included. Every student performs in three public recitals featuring solo concert repertoire, opera arias and opera scenes.

Tuition for each three-week session is \$4,900.

We are accepting applications, evaluating student auditions, and accepting performers in the eventuality that we may all travel to Italy in 2021. We will make our final decision in early May.


For now, we are waiving our \$50 application fee for students. Fully refundable deposits are due by April 15, with the remaining balance due when the program has been confirmed.
