Public Confession

Minister: Let us confess our sins together.

All: Almighty God, I am a sinner. Your Word and my heart confirm that to me. I have done things you have forbidden and left undone things you have commanded. I have not loved you with all my heart, soul, mind, and strength. I have not loved my neighbor as myself. As judge of the whole earth you would be just to condemn me.
