## BACKGROUND

Southern Sudan Healthcare Organization (SSHCO) is a non-profit organization Co-founded by D Jacob Atem and Mr. Lual Deng on March 27, 2008. Both are two of the *Lost Boys of Sudan* who came to America in 2001. Dr. Atem received his Ph.D. in environmental and Global Health from the University of Florida and a former post-doctoral fellow at Johns Hopkins Centre for Humanitarian Health. Mr. Deng received an economics degree with a specialization in international development from

Michigan State University. Together, they drive the vision and message of a safer South Sudan through healthcare and education.

## YEAR OF ESTABLISHMENT

SSHCO was established in the USA as a 501(c)3 organization with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) in 2009. SSHCO officially began working in South Sudan in 2012.

## PROJECT ACTIVITIES

SSHCO has been working in South Sudan since 2011 beginning with the construction of a Primary Health Care Center (PHCC) in Maar, Jonglei State. In 2012 the Health Center was finally equipped and open to the public for health care services. Currently, SSHCO is still running its clinic in Jonglei State, and on September 23, 2020, SSHCO has been responding to Mangalla Humanitarian Site in Central Equatoria State (CES). SSHCO has provided health services to the host communities (Bari and Mundari) and the IDPs from Jonglei State. SSHCO is managing the four mobile clinics in response to the current situation in Mangalla, CES, South Sudan.

## VISION, MISSION, AND GOAL

### **Vision**

To make the village of Maar, Pakeer Payam, Twic East County, Jonglei State, South Sudan the shining example of health sustainable development. SSHCO was built with this vision in mind: To bring health and hope to where it was lost.

### **Mission Statement**

To provide healthcare services, medical supplies, and education to uplift the people of South Sudan and bring hope to where it is lost.

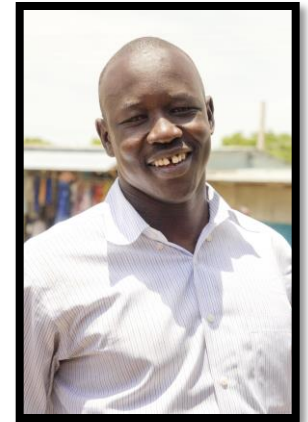
### **Goals**

- To form and maintain relationships that allow for a steady flow of funds to ensure our patients receive the highest quality healthcare.
- To provide resources and funding to South Sudanese individuals hoping to pursue careers in the medical field to ensure wider access to healthcare across the country.
- To build clinics that will focus on maternal healthcare to provide the best future for women and their children.

## CO-FOUNDER AND CEO: DR. JACOB ATEM

Dr. Jacob Atem is the Co-founder and CEO of the Southern Sudan Health Care Organization, a non-profit that provides medical facilities, supplies, and healthcare-education to the people of South Sudan. At the age of six, Dr. Atem traveled over 2,000 miles to escape a brutal civil war in South Sudan that claimed his family. For nearly a decade, he lived in an overcrowded Kenyan refugee camp where hunger and disease were daily struggles. Now recognized as a Lost Boy of Sudan, Dr. Atem is a U.S. citizen and has dedicated his life to healthcare education and medical service. Adhering to SSHCO's mission, which focuses on natives helping natives, Dr. Atem advocates for displaced persons around the world. Under his leadership, SSHCO aims to inspire hope and improve the quality of life for the lost.

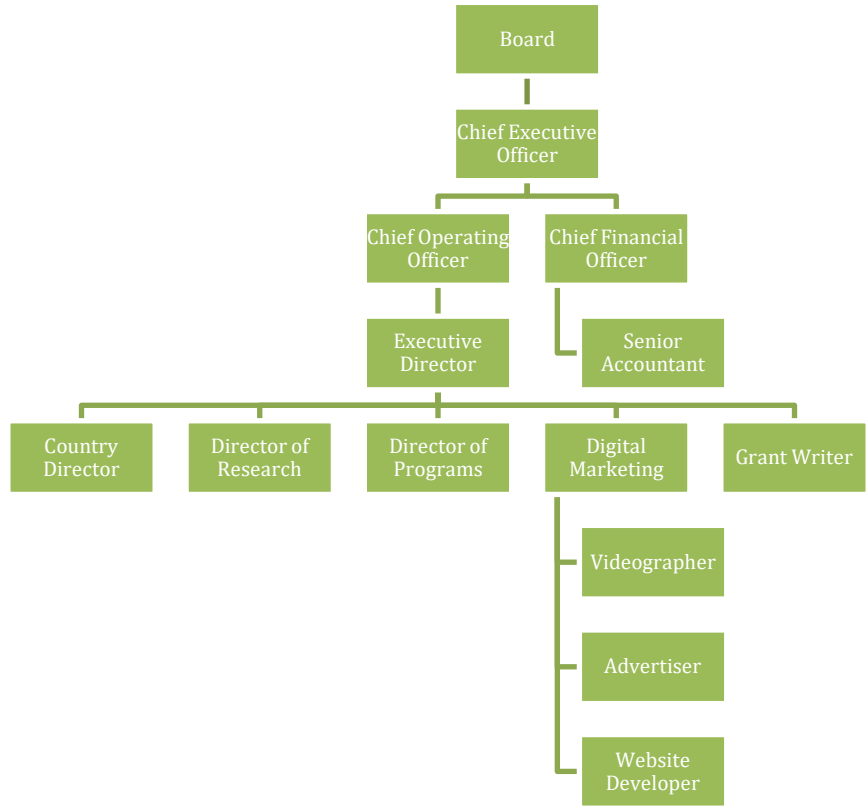

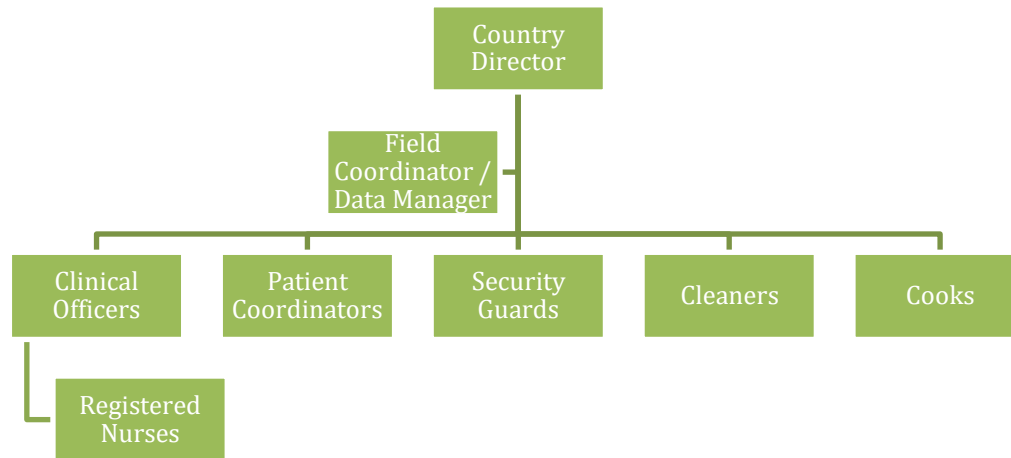
