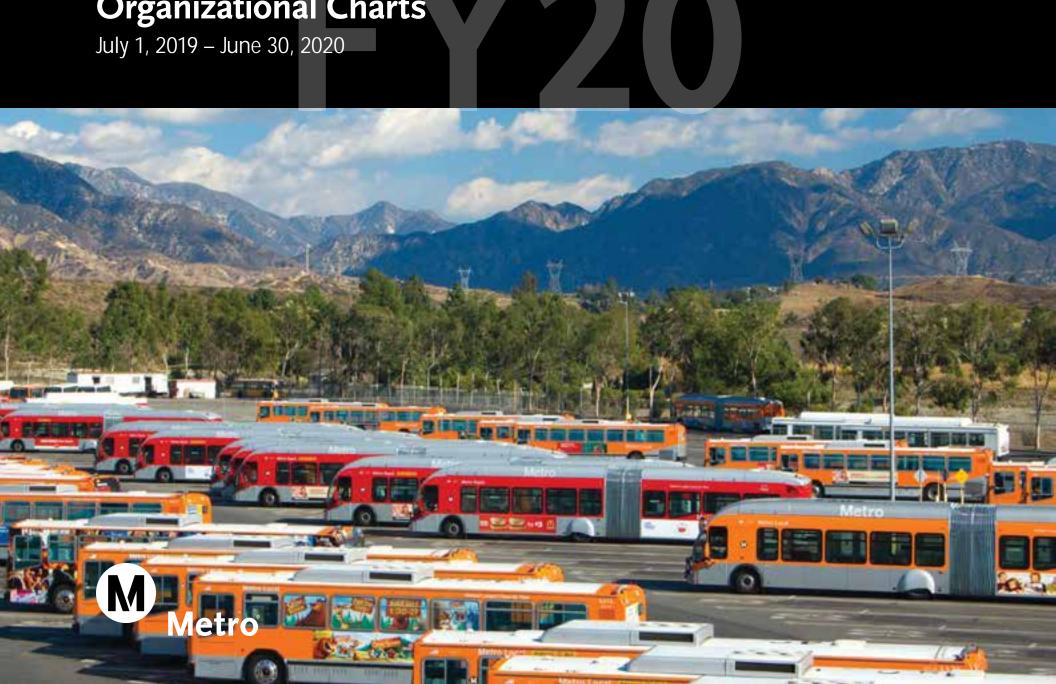

Also, any specific positions that appear in more than one cost center in this book have their "home" budgeted cost center indicated in the position title box, in order to avoid double-counting.
