

MEDICAL AID IN DYING – ASSISTED SUICIDE – SAVES MONEY? A report on assisted dying released on 10/20/20 by the Canadian Parliamentary Budget Officer “calculates that since becoming legal on June 17, 2016, Canada’s health-care costs have dropped C\$86.9 million. The total net reduction in costs from current [medical aid in dying] legislation plus the incremental savings from bill C-7 will add up to \$149 million.” The report stressed the savings “should in no way be interpreted to suggest that assisted dying be used to reduce healthcare costs.” The report went on to note that healthcare costs in the last year of life, especially the last month, are “disproportionately high” and represent 10-20% of total healthcare costs despite patients representing approximately 1% of the population. The report noted that it took 16 years for ‘medically assisted deaths’ in Belgium to rise from .2% to 2.4% of all deaths, while in Canada they are forecast to rise from .3% in 2016 to 2.6% in 2021 – only 5 years. Alex Schadenberg of the Euthanasia Prevention Coalition in Canada estimates that 19,000 Canadians have died since legislation passed there. In addition, the Canadian government has until December 18 to amend the law to comply with a Quebec court ruling that it is unconstitutional to allow euthanasia only for people whose natural death is “reasonably foreseeable”. It is only a matter of time before the same happens here in New York if we do not fight the Assisted Suicide bill that will undoubtedly be pushed forward in the legislative session that begins in January 2021. 
