






The Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph DECEMBER 27, 2020

Sacraments

Baptisms

Baptisms are usually scheduled on the last Sunday of each month after the 11:30 Mass. At this time, baptisms will be scheduled individually, and no group baptisms will be held.

In ordinary times, all parents wishing to have their children baptized at Redemptorist must attend a baptism class before the baptism, and godparents of the child are also encouraged to attend the class. At this time, there are *no* baptism classes. Instead, parents will be asked to review a baptism booklet and prepare for their child's baptism privately.

Baptism classes are held the third Wednesday of each month at 7:00 pm in the Rectory. There will be no baptism classes this month, due to the pandemic. Call the parish office at (816) 561-3771 to register or for more information.

Marriages

To marry at Redemptorist Church, at least one of the couple must be a baptized Catholic, and both must be free to marry in the Catholic Church. At this time, weddings are subject to the same social distancing rules that apply to Mass attendees, with the exception that the bride and groom are not required to wear masks.

Weddings are scheduled on Saturdays at either 11:00 am, 1:30 pm or 6:30 pm. Wedding rehearsals are scheduled the Friday evening before the wedding.

Reconciliation

Redemptorist provides many opportunities for the sacrament of reconciliation. Confessions are heard in the church on Saturdays from 3:00 pm to 4:45 pm and from 7:30 pm to 8:00 pm.

Safety Guidelines

Mass attendance is limited to 400 people in the church at one time. **Everyone must wear a mask** in church, unless you are seated in your pew. **Everyone must wear a mask to receive the Eucharist**, lowering it only briefly to consume. Social distancing of 6 feet is required. **Stewardship**
