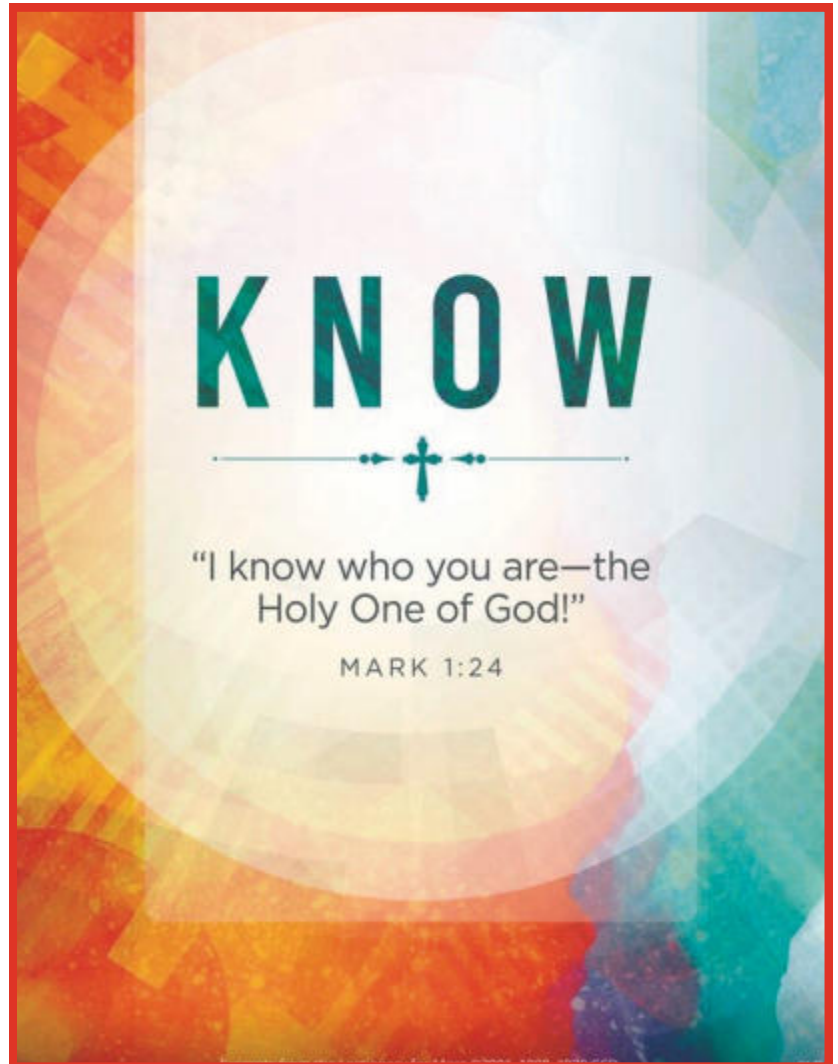
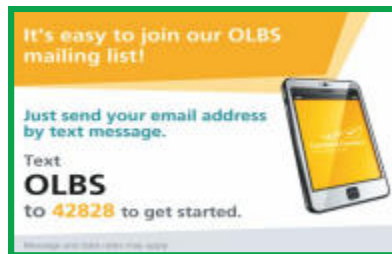

Eucharistic Adoration:

Fridays: Begins after 9am Mass and ends at 10:30am.

Baptism: During pregnancy, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for a special blessing of the child in the womb. Soon after birth, call the secretary to arrange an interview with a staff member and details on STARTING POINT, our present enrichment program.

Confession / Reconciliation: Confessions will be heard on Saturdays from 4pm to 4:45pm, or by appointment with one of the priests.

Marriage: Soon after engagement, approach any priest or deacon after Mass for the special blessing of an engaged couple. Call the secretary at least six months prior to the desired wedding date to begin BETTER TOGETHER, our couple's enrichment program.

Anointing of the Sick: Please call the rectory to arrange for a priest to celebrate this sacrament due to serious illness, a planned medical procedure, or advanced age.

Communion of the Sick: The clergy and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion attend to the home-bound sick. Please call Agnes at 718 631-4793 or the secretary to arrange temporary or long-term coverage.

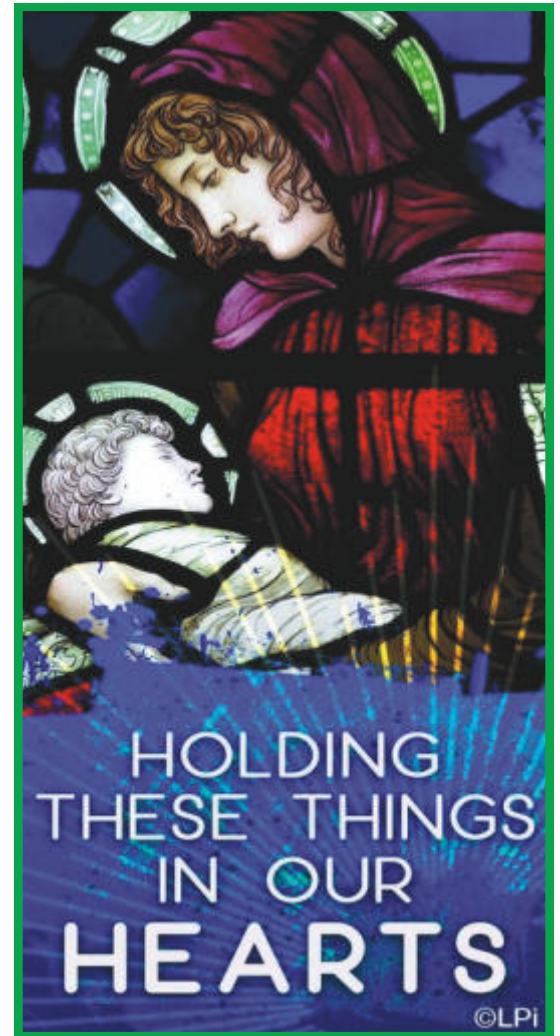

From the Pastor's Desk....



Dear Parishioners,

Go to Joseph! This is the Church's constant plea to all those seeking guidance, help, and protection. It is inscribed on the baldachino over the altar of St. Joseph Co-Cathedral in Brooklyn: *Ite ad Joseph*. It is reminiscent of Joseph, son of Jacob, in the Book of Genesis, to whom his brothers go in time of hunger to receive Pharaoh's grain. Our Holy Father, Pope Francis, has a life-long devotion to St. Joseph. His daily morning offering concludes with a devotional prayer to the saint, and he offers us another to pray, which I will conclude with. He keeps a statue of a reclining Joseph in his bedroom to whom he entrusts the church's challenges each night at bedtime. Writing them down and putting them under the saint's pillow, he says, "I'm going to sleep now, Joseph, you take care of these problems." So it was not surprising that on the 150th anniversary of the declaration of St. Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church, the Holy Father proclaimed, in an Apostolic Letter *Patris Corde* (With a Father's Heart) a "Year of Saint Joseph" from December 8, 2020, to December 8, 2021. Your Pastoral Staff and Parish Council have been exploring opportunities for us, individually and as a parish, to benefit from this year by increasing our devotion to St. Joseph and imitating his many virtues. To begin with, we are celebrating a Votive Mass of Saint Joseph each Wednesday (a day traditionally given over to him) whenever the liturgical calendar allows. The Litany of St. Joseph can conclude those Masses. At other times we will make use of this prayer that the Holy Father encourages us to pray.

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer,
 Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary.
 To you God entrusted his only Son;
 In you Mary placed her trust;
 With you Christ became man.
 Blessed Joseph, to us too,
 Show yourself a father
 And guide us in the path of life.
 Obtain for us grace, mercy, and courage,
 And defend us from every evil. Amen.
