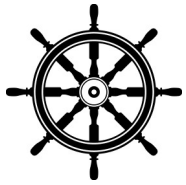

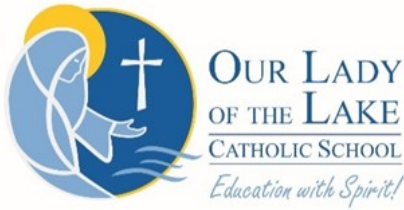

Juan Ana Coffee Sales

Since 2014, mission groups from Our Lady of the Lake have been traveling to San Lucas Toliman, Guatemala to learn from and serve the Mayan people of the region. In 2015, we started selling Juan Ana coffee to raise funds to pay for one of the many wood charity houses our group helps to build each summer.

Juan Ana Cafe is produced through the mission in San Lucas. Ripe coffee beans are purchased directly from small, independent growers at above market price, then roasted, packaged and shipped to Minnesota for sale. Proceeds from sales of the coffee support all mission programs.

Purchase your bag of Juan Ana coffee to provide a family in need with a new home. Coffee will be sold after all Masses on May 20th, as part of the Mission Trip Cinnamon Roll Fundraiser.
