Dear Parishioners,

After a year of prayer and discernment **Rick Duda** from our Lady of the Woods will be enrolled as a candidate for the diaconate within the Archdiocese of Chicago at Mundelein Seminary. It is my intention to be present at the Chapel of Saint Mary of the Lake for this important liturgy. Candidacy is the first official recognition of his vocation to the diaconate, which must be confirmed in the next three years of formation. This period includes spiritual direction, theological reflection, pastoral ministry experiences, academic course, field education and more.

Rick began this journey over a year ago through a process called Aspirancy. This included spiritual formation, a course on the Catechism of the Catholic Church, days of reflection, retreats, and opportunities to more deeply understand the ministries of Word, Liturgy, and Charity that are the hallmarks of the diaconal ministry.

Rick is a very active parishioner. His wife, Kim, is the Director of Religious Education at Our Lady of the Woods and is actively supportive of this discernment. Their four sons have all been involved in parish life. Please keep Rick, Kim, and all those involved in formation in your prayers as they continue this journey.

Those who are attending Mass know that we have returned to paper bulletins. I do want to highlight a feature that many of you might find helpful. You can also receive your bulletin, in color through your e-mail every Saturday morning. It is very easy to sign up and comes at no cost. Simply go to the parish website and then scroll down the homepage. Near the bottom you will see, in the center, a tab to receive the bulletin. Just follow the prompts and each week the bulletin will be sent to you. This is especially helpful when traveling, when being away from Our Lady of the Woods for a length of time, or if one is homebound.

On Sunday, August 29<sup>th</sup> we will have two outdoor Masses to close out the summer and welcome everyone back as the new academic and social year begins. Weather permitting these will be at the 11:00 and 6:00 pm. Hospitality will be provided at these Masses as well.

The Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is an approach to the religious formation of children. It is rooted in the Bible, the liturgy of the church and the educational principles of Maria Montessori. Children gather in an "atrium," a room prepared for them, which contains simple yet beautiful materials that they work with to draw closer to Christ in prayer.

### WHAT DO CHILDREN LEARN?

Children spend time enjoying and nurturing a relationship with the Good Shepherd, who is Jesus. The children are deeply affected by the boundless love of the Shepherd for His sheep as described in the Scriptures. They learn that He knows His sheep, calls them by name, searches for a lost sheep, and celebrates the found sheep.

#### A BETTER UNDERSTANDING FOR CHILDREN

Materials and presentations on the life of Christ and His teachings help to make the great mystery of who God is more understandable for the child. Through geography, the words of the prophets, and infancy narratives, Jesus is established as a real person. The Paschal narratives are treated similarly, using model cities of Jerusalem, empty tombs, and cenacles for the Last Supper. Selected parables further the child's wonder and curiosity about the great mystery of the Kingdom of God.

### **ATRIUM ACTIVITIES**

Children become familiar with the articles of the Eucharist and Baptism by arranging them in their own atrium on miniature altars and fonts. The children also become acquainted with the gestures of our liturgy and their meaning of the Paschal Mystery: Christ has died, Christ is risen and Christ will come again. A prayer corner located in each atrium reflects the liturgical time of year by means of appropriate colors, prayer, songs, artwork and readings.





# **WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION:** Reduce outdoor watering waste.

Experts estimate that 50 percent of the water we use outdoors goes to waste from evaporation, wind, or runoff due to overwatering. Frequent lawn watering is expensive and often unnecessary. A typical lawn only needs about one inch of water per week to survive. So if there is no rain, water every 6-8 days to reduce your water bill. A best practice: water for 15 minutes then allow the water to soak in for a while and repeat 3-4 times, lessening waste of water run-off. This deeper soaking technique encourages the roots to grow deeper and be more drought resistant. Water early in the morning or at sunset to reduce loss from evaporation. Check the spigots for leaks.
