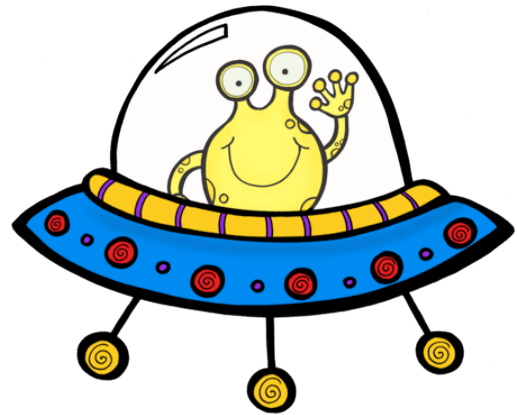
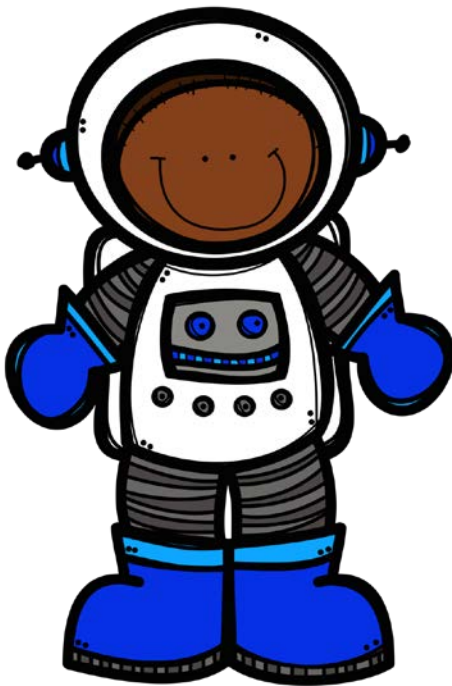

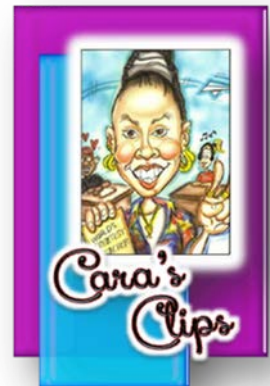

Sun and Moon

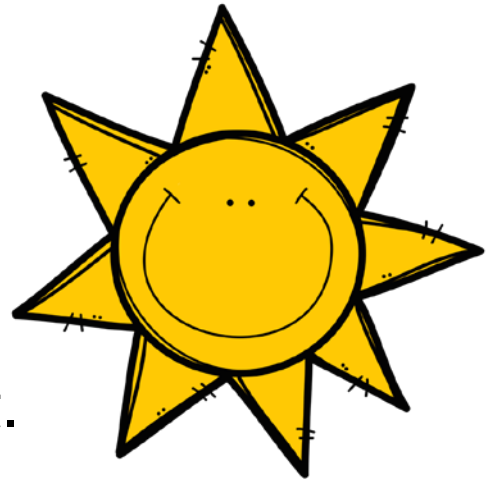

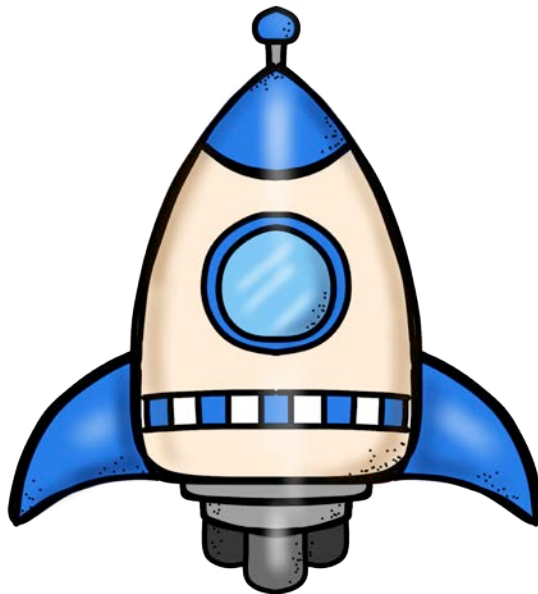

Climb Aboard The Spaceship

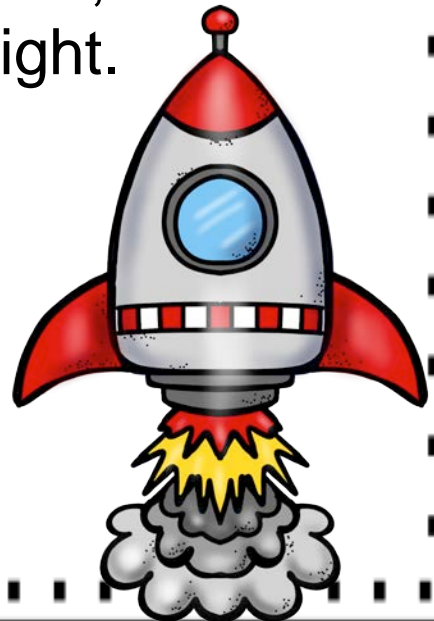

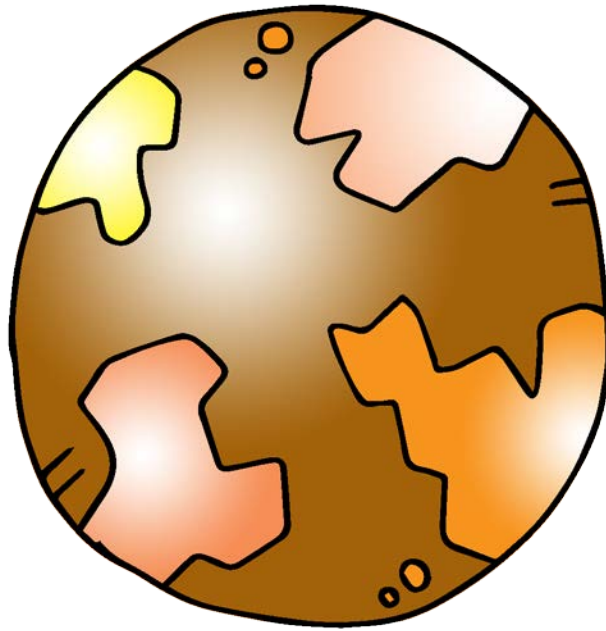
Climb aboard the spaceship,

(Sung to: *"Here We Go Around the Mulberry Bush"*)

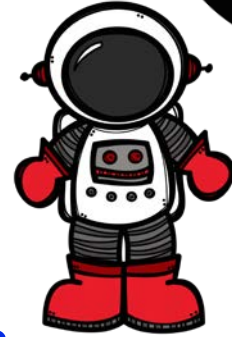
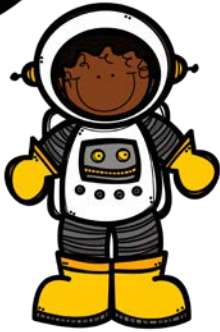

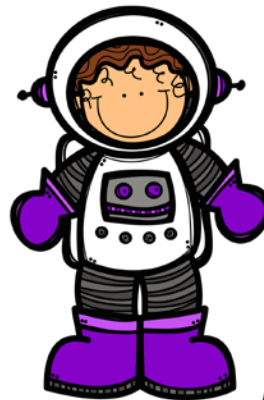
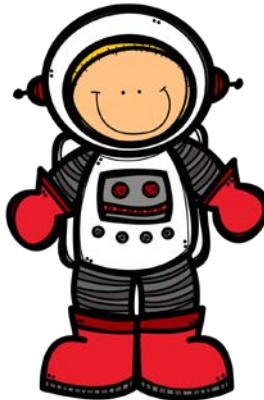
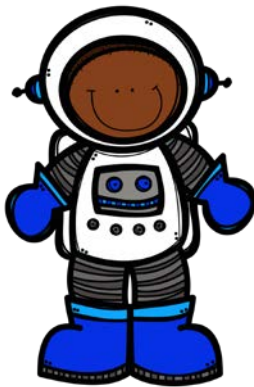
As you continue the song, ask the children

zoomed out of sight!

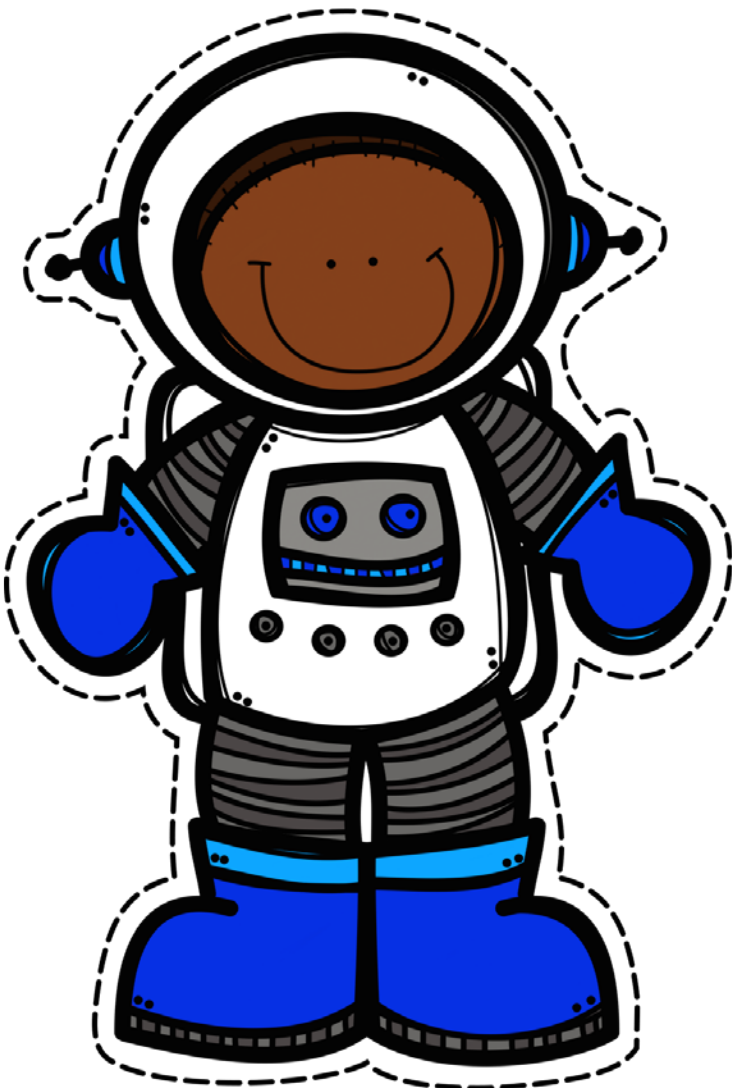
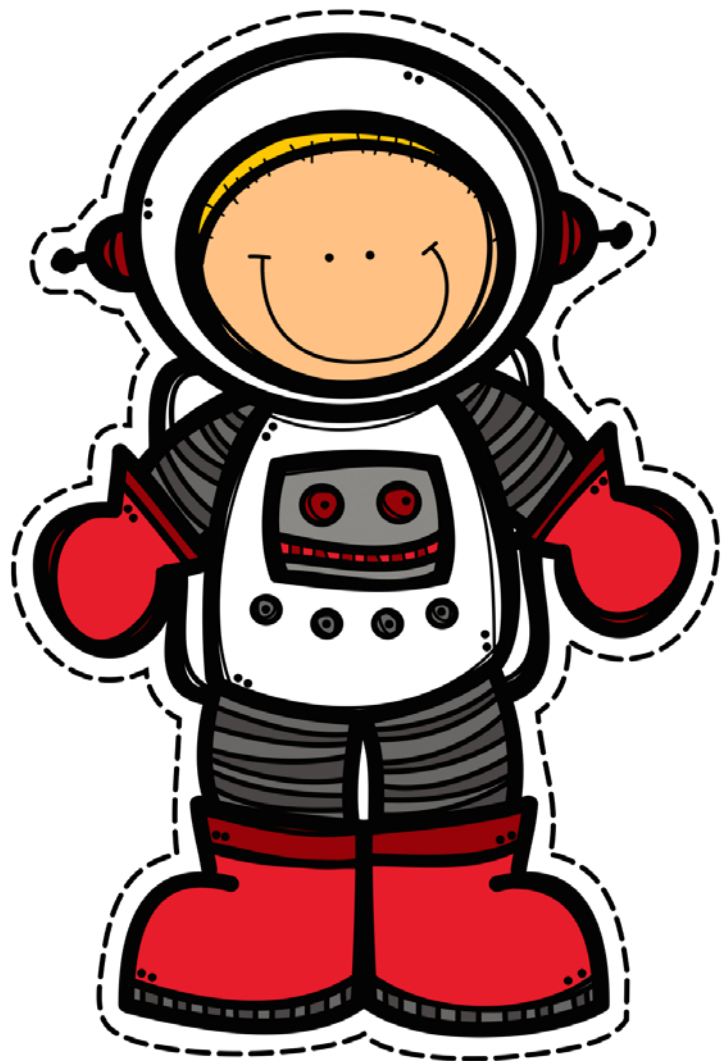


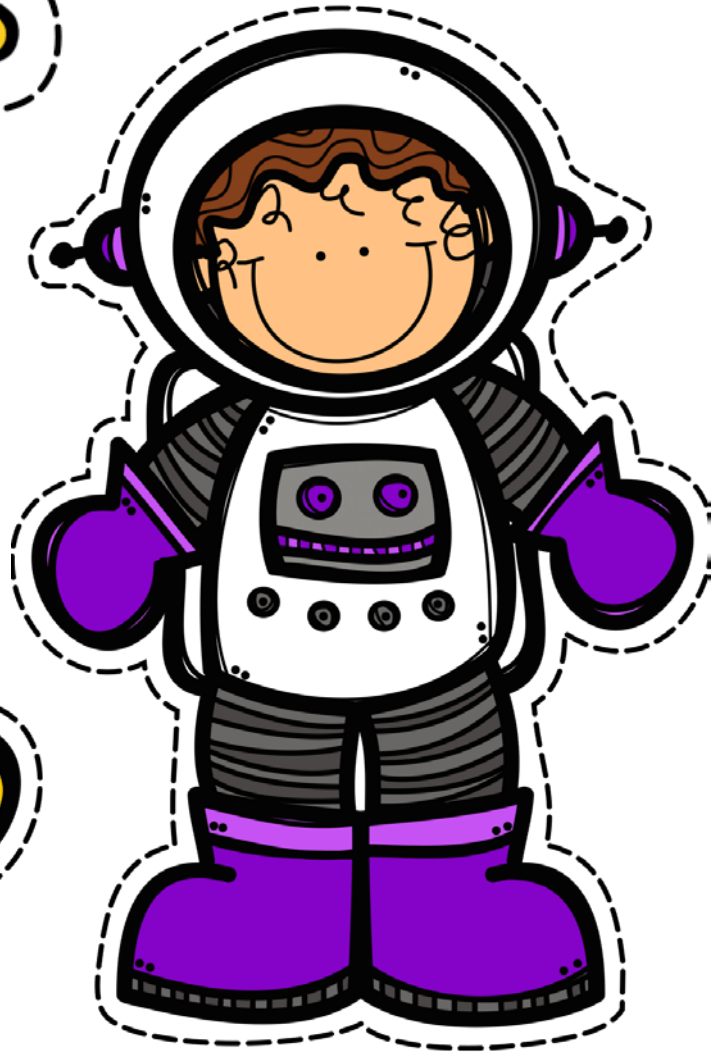
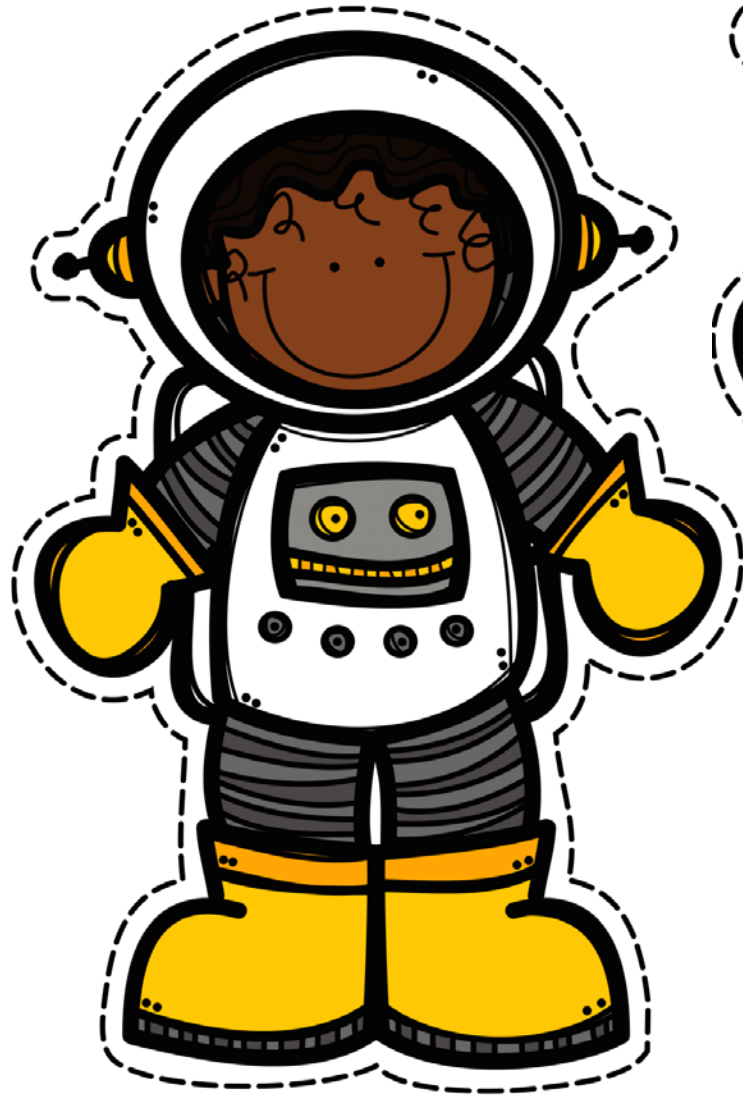
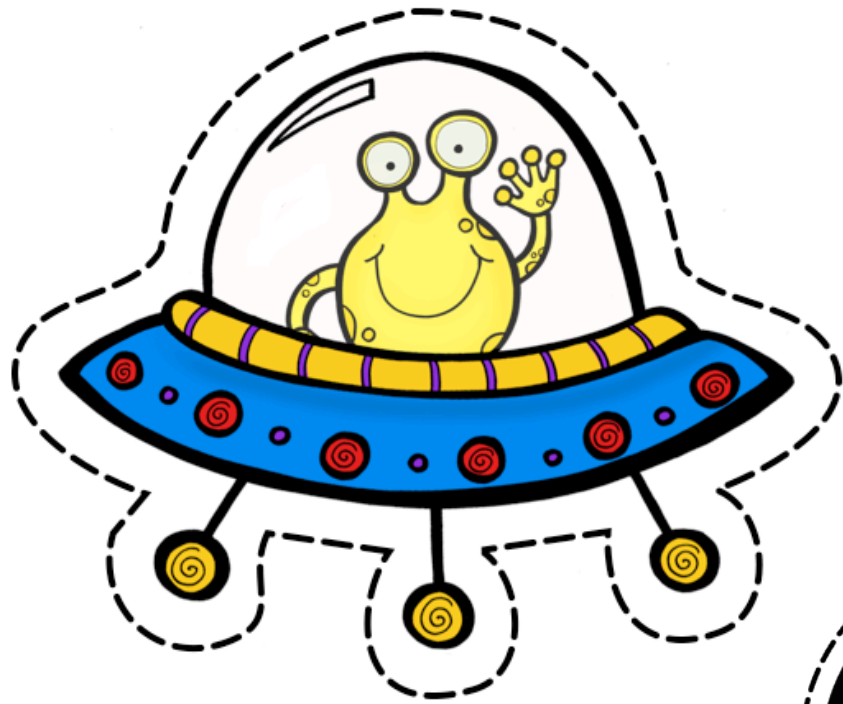
5 Little Astronauts Flannel Story Directions

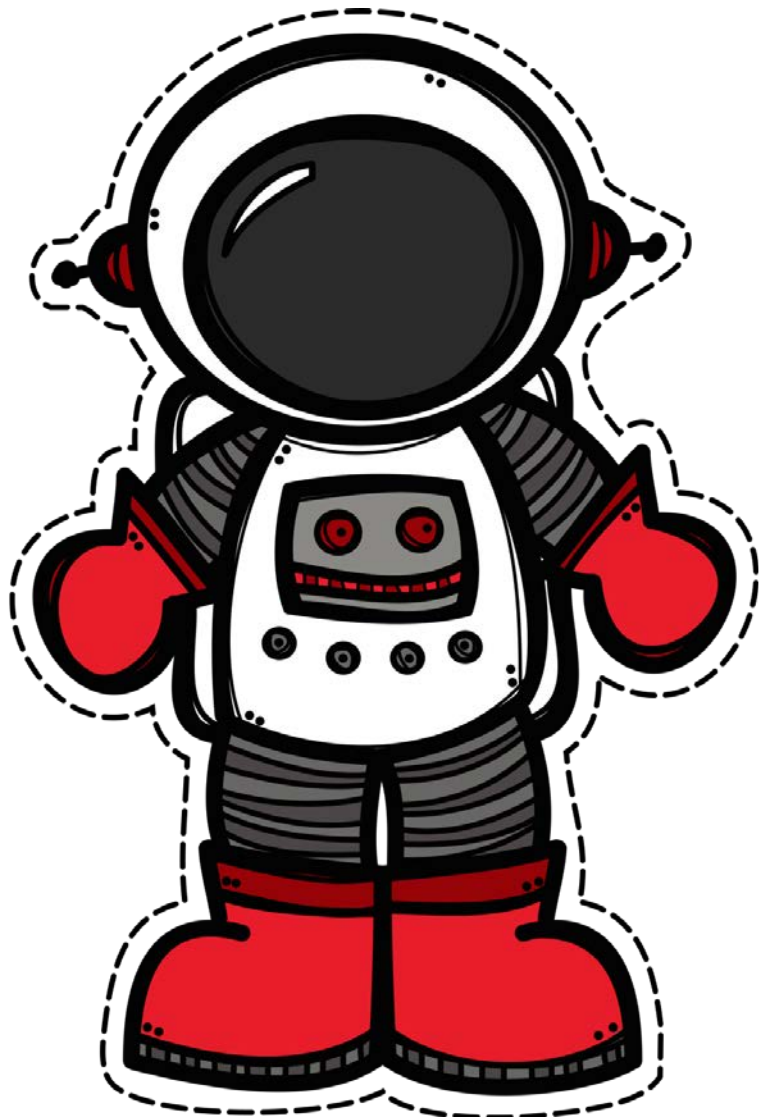
- Print up on white card stock.

- Use astronauts, stars and aliens as flannel story for 5 Little Astronauts.

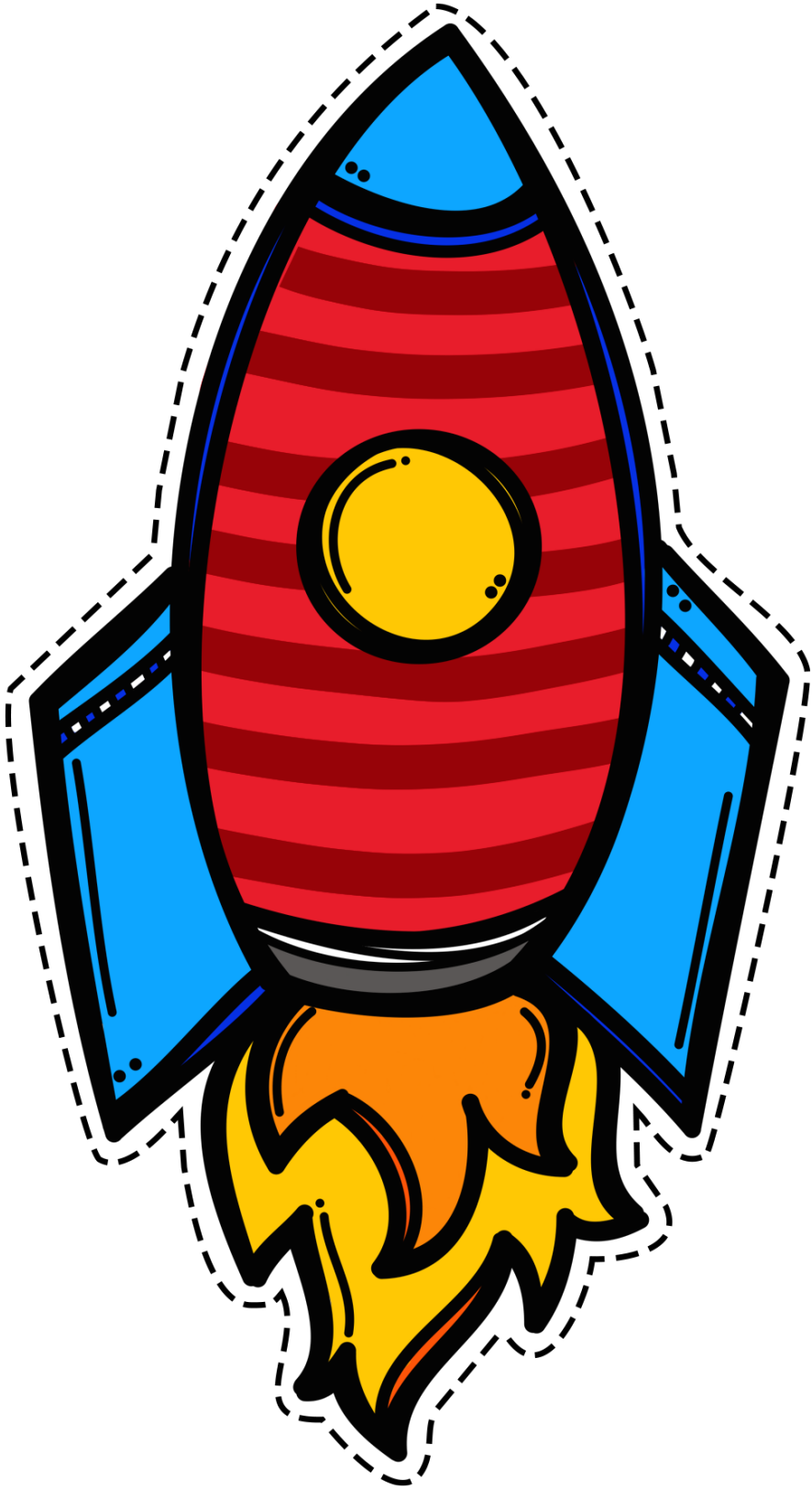
Another option:

(Sung to: "One Little, Two Little, Three Little Indian")

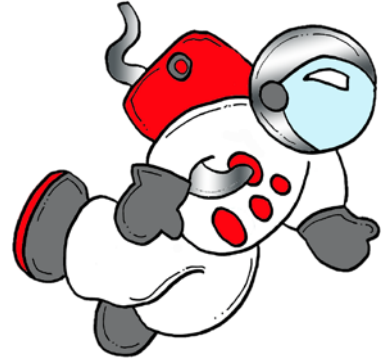
One little, two little, three little planets.

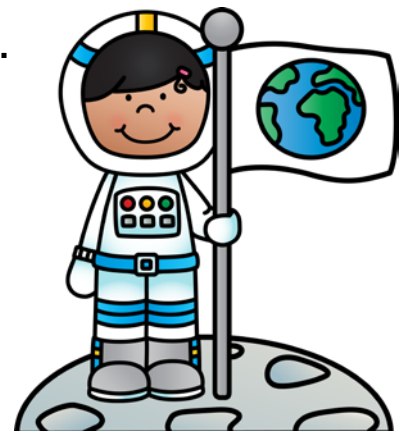

Astronauts Flannel Story Directions

- Print up on white card stock.

Use as puppets.

Use during circle time as a counting activity. Lay moon on the table and let children add astronaut to the moon each verse.
