

SINGER® PROJECTS DIY Cape from Scarves



Refashion your winter scarves to make this simple DIY cape! This project is simple and sophisticated, making it the perfect addition to your cold-weather closet.

PROJECT SKILL LEVEL:



Shopping List

Everything you need to complete this project in one place. Use this convenient checklist to ensure you have all required materials in your sewing room, or take it with you while you shop for supplies.

*please include a 1/4" seam allowance when shopping for fabric.

- Two Scarves
- o Sewing Scissors
- o All-Purpose Thread
- o Pins





Project Steps

1. Gather your materials. Right sides together, put one scarf on top of the other one. Pin them together on <u>one</u> long edge.



2. Stitch half the length of the scarf.





- 3. Fold lining up your short ends--right sides together. Using a straight stitch, stop sewing about ¾" from the fold to create armholes.
 - a. <u>Pictured below:</u> "x" marks the armhole/where you should stop stitching. Be sure to backstitch when you reach the armhole.



4. Fold all the edges over twice (1/4") to create a hem. Pin. Using a zig zag stitch, seal over your fold to create a neat hem. Press.







5. Style your cape, and make a statement!
