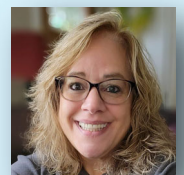

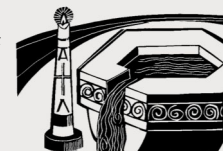
Thank you so much for your many kindnesses, condolences, and prayers. May God bless and keep Notre Dame Church in his imperishable spirit of love and peace.

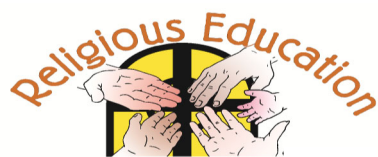

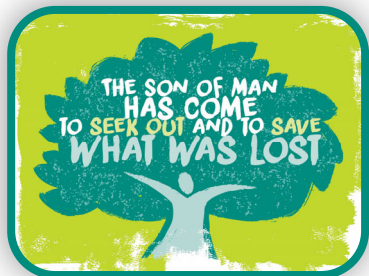
