Rosalino.



After more than 34 years holding forth on the Old Capitol Plaza in downtown Springfield, it's still the lure of the soup that brings folks in the door. Each morning, the restaurant sets up the stockpots and creates six or seven different varieties from scratch for the daily lunch crowd.

In the beginning, there were only two choices: mushroom bisque and beef barley. Eventually, customers wanted more, and the owners quickly added new options. The No. 1 seller continues to be the robust, creamy Wisconsin cheese, made with Cheddar and a bit of beer; the venerable mushroom, cream of broccoli and French potato follow closely.

Whether it's five above zero with a windchill -10 or 95 in July, the soup still anchors lunch. At Christmas, hundreds and hundreds of quarts fly out the door, ending up on the central Illinois holiday tables. Some of the soups have become the first "real food" parents have fed their babies, and now those babies are bringing in kids of their own.

Recipes for home-sized quantities of the beef barley, mushroom bisque, and cheese are available on request.
