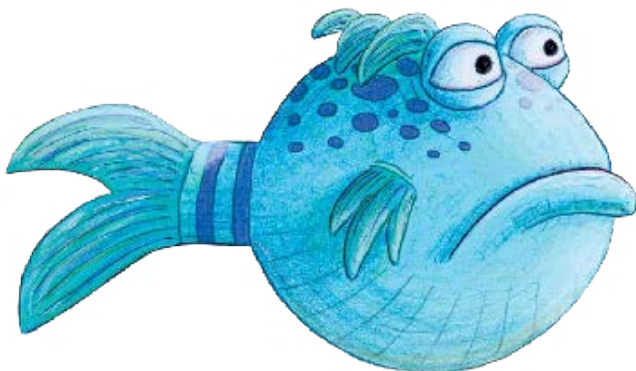
DOG MAN: THE MUSICAL

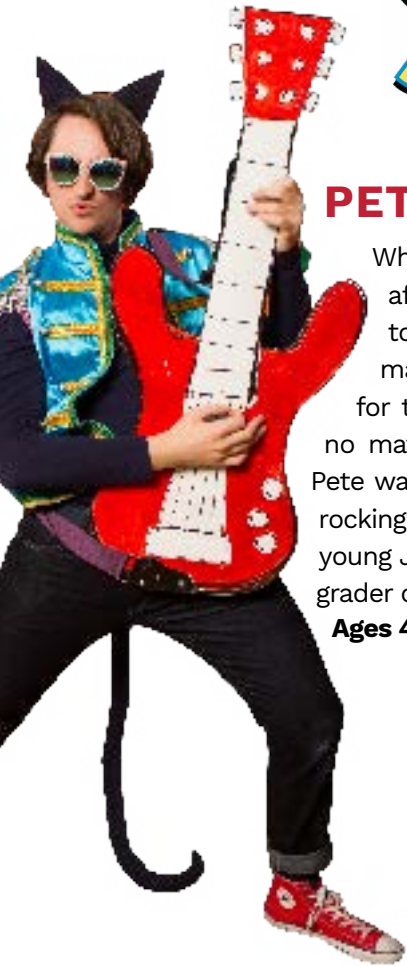

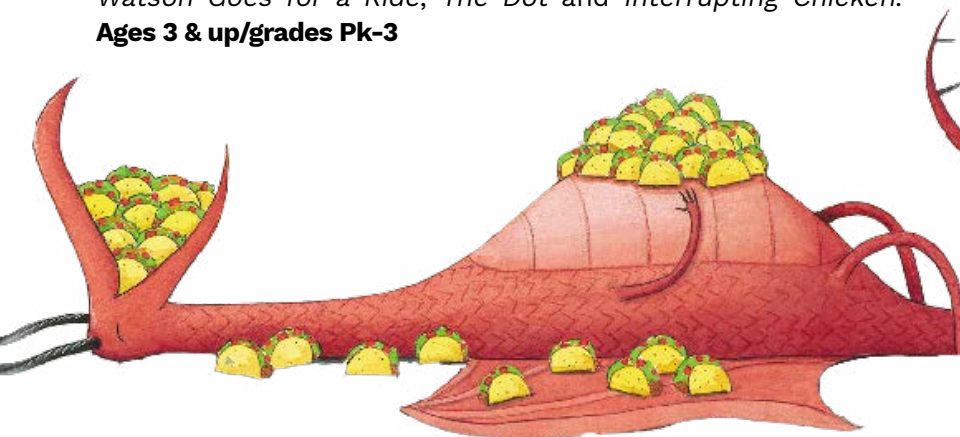

CLICK CLACK MOO

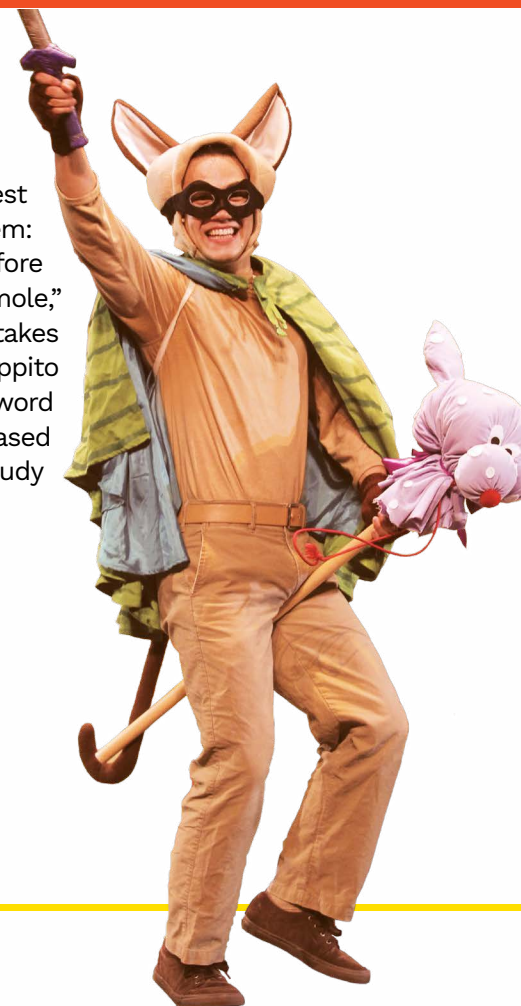

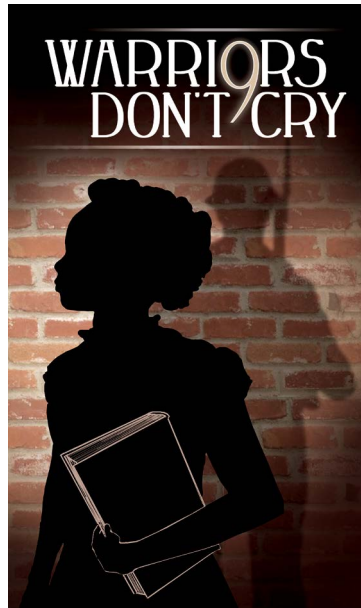

FREEDOM TRAIN

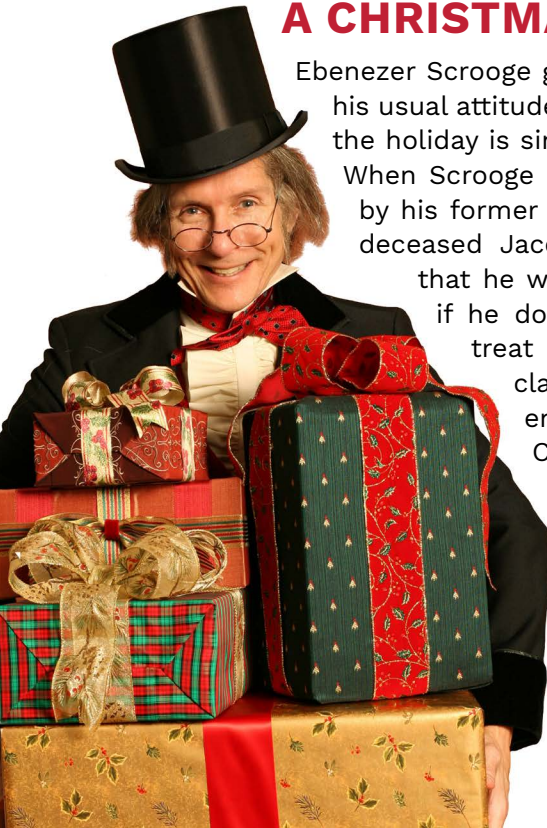

In this interactive production, students become some of the brave people who took part in this historic expedition that explored the newly acquired Louisiana Purchase.

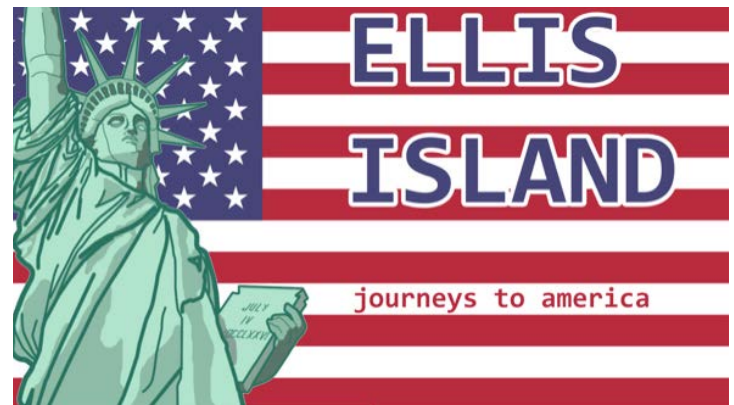

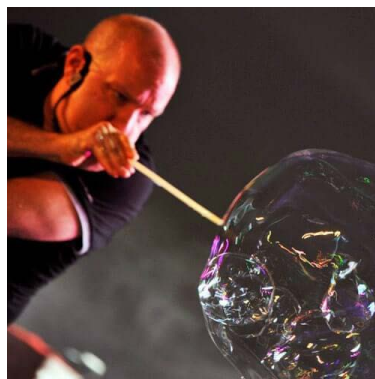
