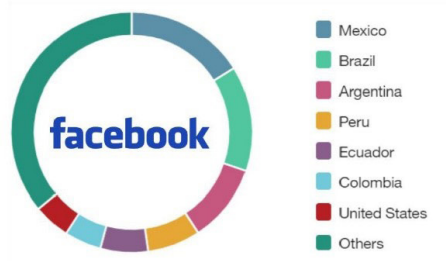

IJF Doha 2020 Seminar

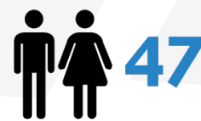
