## Q & A

### Question:

For some reason, I cannot seem to do lateral flexion with my horse. I am pretty sure she hasn't had any bad experiences, but I have worked on it every day for the last 5 days and nothing seems to work. Once she gets her head half way there, she will then turn her hindquarters around. What should I do?

### Answer:

Just hang in there...never seen it take longer than 2 days! Set it up, wait patiently, rubbing your horse as you wait, and don't release until your horse stands still...then release right away so she understands she did the right thing. (Naturally, if your horse panicked you'd have to let go. Don't get into a fight, but if you offer it gently your horse will not panic. Just stay with her until she works it out). One other thought is to get her to do it on the ground first. Oh! And make sure your body is relaxed and your hand with the rein comes to just above your knee and not your belly button. Going to the belly button is an Indirect Rein and it asks the horse's hind legs to move!
