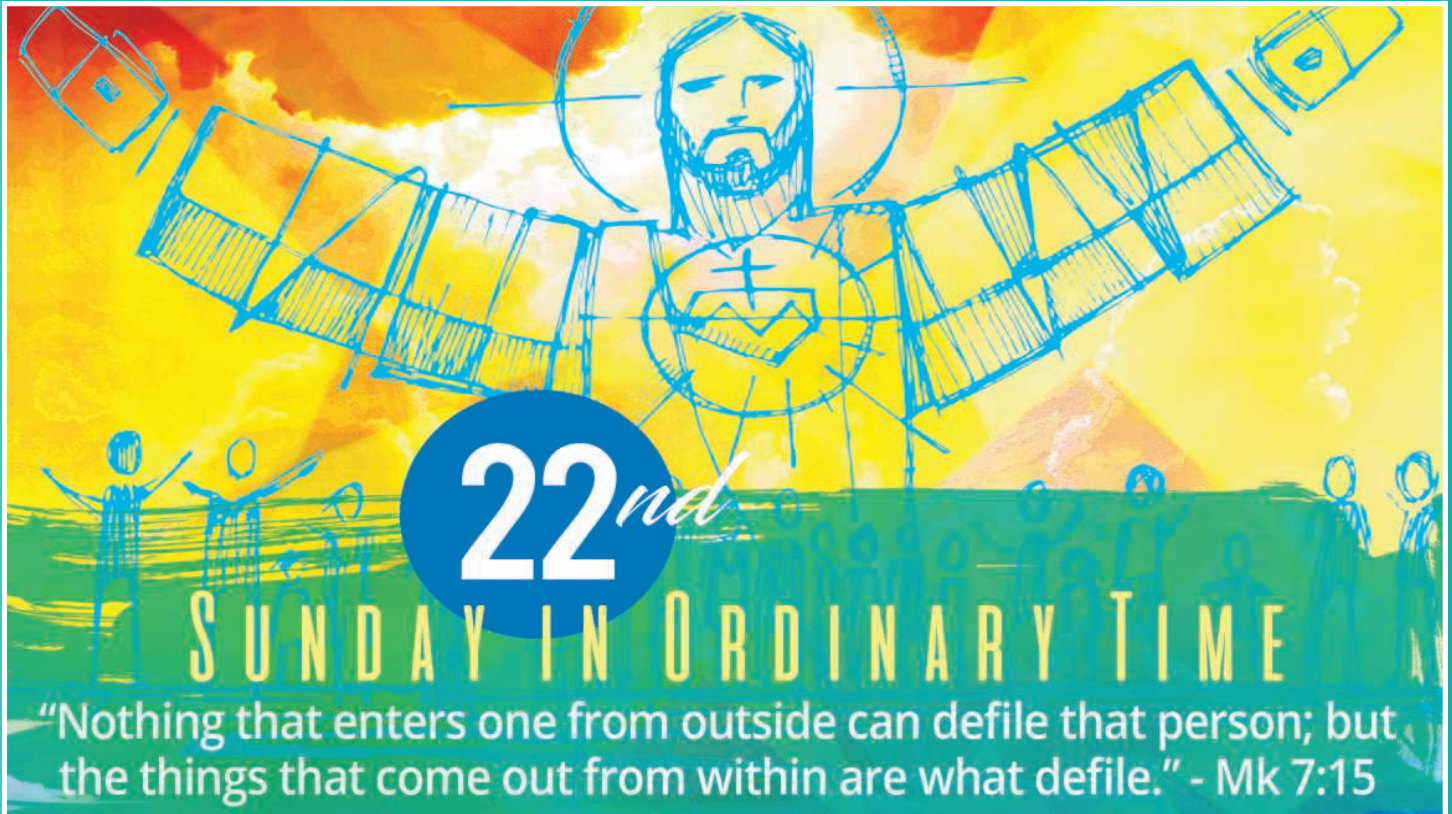

## Pastor's Column.....

**Saint Mother Teresa of Calcuta** - "Not all of us can do great things. But we can do small things with great love." - Mother Teresa Two years ago on September 4, 2016 Pope Francis canonized Mother Teresa as a saint. Her feast day is celebrated this week on September 5<sup>th</sup>. It is not often that in one's life time that someone we had learned so much about, and likely admired from a distance, is canonized. Most of the saints we know are from centuries ago, but in Mother Teresa we heard speak, saw her on our TVs, read about her and now she is a saint from our own time. This small lady of all about 5 feet, born Anjezë Gonxhe Bojaxhiu in Albania on August 26, 1910, was such a strong advocate for the poorest of the poor. As the quote above reflects she also had a way of keeping things in perspective yet also had her struggles of faith. The following prayer is attributed to her and it too I believe tries to show us how to keep life in perspective. It is appropriately titled.

### *Do it Anyway*

People are often unreasonable, irrational, and self-centered. Forgive them anyway.

If you are kind, people may accuse you of selfish, ulterior motives. Be kind anyway.

If you are successful, you will win some unfaithful friends and some genuine enemies. Succeed anyway.

If you are honest and sincere people may deceive you. Be honest and sincere anyway.

What you spend years creating, others could destroy overnight. Create anyway.

If you find serenity and happiness, some may be jealous. Be happy anyway.

The good you do today, will often be forgotten. Do good anyway.

Give the best you have, and it will never be enough. Give your best anyway.

In the final analysis, it is between you and God. It was never between you and them anyway.

Nancy and Ed are preparing a summary of the comments from the evening and we will be sharing that with all of you in the next week. The next step in this process are for representatives from the parish to join with representatives from the other parishes in our Deanery for a similar evening on October 19 at a location the archdiocese has not yet chosen. 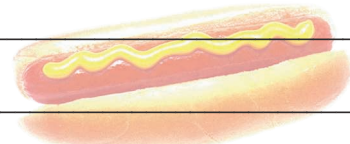

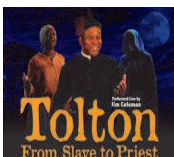
